

## UNIVERSITY HONORS CAPSTONE GRANT SPRING 2008 APPLICATION

The University Honors Program has designated funds for grants to students for research and other projects leading toward the completion of their senior Honors Capstone. Awards will be determined on the basis of the Capstone project's merit and feasibility, in addition to the impact of the grant on the completion of the Capstone. No award will exceed \$500.00. Applications will be accepted at this time only for those students registering for all or part of their Capstone in spring 2008.

**The deadline for the spring 2008 application is Monday, February 11.**

To be considered for a Capstone Grant:

1. Complete the University Honors Capstone Grant application, including a detailed cost estimate (on reverse).
2. On a separate sheet of paper, please state the objectives of the research project and how the grant will enhance your Capstone.
3. Obtain the necessary signatures on the grant application form and attach all paperwork to your completed Capstone Grant application.
4. Attach the Capstone Grant application form and paperwork to the Honors Capstone form and submit it to the University Honors Center in Hurst Hall 206 by the deadline.  
Keep a copy for your records.
5. Optional: Capstone advisors may attach a letter addressed to Professor Michael Mass, Director, University Honors Program, in support of the student's capstone grant request.
