**Tuition**

Tuition for the four day commuter program is \$250. Campers are responsible for bringing their own lunch or they may purchase food from several on-campus locations.

**Objectives:**

The objective of the American Field Hockey Camp is to provide a fun and competitive atmosphere, with the best camp to coach ratio possible. Campers will grow under level-specific coaching by top area coaches and international players. Special attention will be given to advancing basic skills, thereby creating opportunity for players to absorb more complex facets of the game. Goalkeepers will receive special attention, focusing on mental aspects of the game, agility, and basic skill techniques. Campers will be grouped according to skill level and experience.

**Deposit:**

A non-refundable deposit of \$100 must accompany this application to secure a space in camp. Application and deposit must be postmarked by June 15 to reserve a space. Upon receipt of deposit and application, campers will receive a confirmation letter and detailed information regarding the camp.

**Payment:**

Personal checks will be accepted for deposits and any balance paid before June 15. Please do not send any correspondence through the mail after that date. After June 15, all payments must be made in person on the day of registration. Outstanding balances can be paid at the time of registration.
