

Barry Goldberg

One of the finest coaches in the nation, Barry Goldberg enters his 15th season as the head coach of the American University volleyball program. Responsible for the dramatic rise of the program, he has established the team as a domineering power in the Patriot League and the Northeast Region. The Eagles have qualified for the NCAA Tournament four out of the last six years and have captured league titles five of the last six years.



The architect of a model program, Goldberg has led American to 20 or more wins in 13 of his 14 seasons at the helm. He owns an overall record of 352-136 for an incredible .721 winning percentage, which ranks him among the top-20 active collegiate coaches in the country. A four-time Coach of the Year honoree and the 2001 Patriot League Coach of the Year, Goldberg has produced numerous All-Conference, Regional All-American and Academic All-America selections including the 2002 Verizon Academic All-America Volleyball Player of the Year, Karla Kucerkova.

For the last 13 summers, Goldberg has conducted both individual and team volleyball camps at American and other locations in the Mid-Atlantic region. In 1997, he served as the United States representative along with the Tampa Bay Juniors Volleyball Club at a four-nation international camp in Europe. Elite junior national teams from Switzerland, Slovakia, and the Czech Republic hosted the camps. He has also held seminars in the National Mizuno Coaching Clinic Series and serves as a voting member of the national AVCA/USA Today Top 25 Coaches poll.

A native of Pittsburgh, Pa., Goldberg is a 1984 graduate of the University of Pittsburgh with a bachelor's degree in communication and rhetoric. He went on to receive his master's in Counseling Education in 1986 from Pittsburgh. A standout on the court, Goldberg was captain of the men's varsity volleyball team at Pittsburgh that finished with a national ranking of 13th in 1983. From 1985-86, Goldberg was the assistant women's volleyball coach for his alma mater. In 1987, he was the coach of the Capital Volleyball Club where all of the players he coached secured scholarships at Division I institutions. Goldberg then went on to serve as the assistant coach at Georgetown before coming to American.

Overview/Schedule

Barry Goldberg, American University Head Volleyball Coach and Patriot League Coach of the Year, will be hosting a four-day volleyball camp from Monday, July 28 through Thursday, July 31, 2003.

The Schedule:

Monday

8 - 9 AM: Registration

Tuesday

Wednesday

1:30 - 4:30 PM: Team Defense

Thursday

9 - Noon: Video Analysis

Each session will involve different activities including: individual technique, drill and skill development, video analysis of individual players and competitive games.

Campers will be grouped by ability and will receive small group instruction covering all aspects of the game.
