### The Coaches

American University is coached by **Shann Hart** (Norfolk State '88), who is in her fourth season leading the Eagles, and seventh overall as a collegiate head coach. Hart has a career record of 116-85 [.577]. Hart led American to 18 wins last season, the most since the 1997-98 season. She is assisted by **Glenn Rigney** (Miami '79), **Deb Reardon** (Assumption '86), **Brian Johnson** (Drexel '98) and graduate manager **Quintina Walker** (William & Mary '02).

Brown is coached by **Jean Marie Burr** (New Hampshire '77), who is in her 16th season with the Bears. Burr owns a career record of 212-194 (.522), all with Brown. Burr is assisted by **Pamela Bass** (Brown '91), **Jessica Viertlboeck** (Ohio Wesleyan '01) and **Casimir Grygorcewicz** (Quinnipiac '74).

## LAST TIME OUT

Despite a 9-0 run early in the first half and **Chanel Hunt's** 16 points, the Eagles were unable to catch Elon Tuesday at Bender Arena, and lost, 72-53.

With eight first half rebounds, including four offensive boards, Elon's 6-5 center Courtney Nyborg helped the Phoenix a six-point lead going into the second stanza. Elon scored 11 second chance points in the first period, compared with the Eagles' two. In addition, the Phoenix took 11 free-throws in the first half compared with the Eagles two and made seven compared with the Eagles one.

AU had taken a lead at 13-8 at the 13:08 mark after a nine-point run. Unfortunately, Elon responded with a 20-5 run that ended at 5:39 of the first half, with the Phoenix leading, 28-18.

With 4:03 left in the first half, Elon was able to take the largest lead of the stanza at 11, but the Eagles fought back and closed the gap to five. At halftime, **Kaitlin Schuyler** put up nine points for the Eagles, while Holly Andrews led Elon with 11.

In the second half, Elon continued to extend its lead over the Eagles with a 12-4 run early in the half. AU came no closer than 13 the rest of the way.

Andrews put up a game high 21 points for Elon, while **Chanel Spriggs** put up seven points and 10 boards for the Eagles. In addition, Schuyler posted 13 points and two boards.

## THE OPPONENT AND THE HISTORY

This is just the third meeting of American University and the Bears of Brown University. The teams met for the first time in December of 1990 in the Lady Rams Classic, hosted by Fordham University. Brown captured that first contest, 55-48. AU and BU did not meet again until 1997, when the Eagles traveled to Providence and came away with a 84-61 victory. The Bears enter today's contest with a 3-6 mark, with wins over Fairleigh Dickinson, New Hampshire and San Diego St. Four of the Bears' six losses have come by seven points or less.

## ON THIS DATE

The Eagles defeated Rider, 96-68, on Jan. 2, 1992. The 96 points are the ninth-highest single-game total in school history, and the win was part of a 16-12 season, the first winning season since the 1986-87 season.

## SPRIGGS SETS SCHOOL CAREER STEALS RECORD

With her six steals versus UMBC on Dec. 18, senior guard **Chanel Spriggs** took over the top spot in American University school history in career steals, breaking the record of former Eagle Jody Thornton, who had 244 steals between 1983 and 1987. As of Dec. 15, Spriggs was averaging 3.7 steals per game, good for 14th in the NCAA.

Spriggs 110 steals in the 2001-2002 season set the school's single-season record for most steals. She established new AU, Patriot League and Bender Arena records with 11 steals against Holy Cross on Jan. 26, 2003. In addition, after her 36 steals in nine games this season (4.0/game), Spriggs cracked into the top-10 for career steals in Patriot League history. Lafayette's Heidi Caruso, who played for the Leopards between 1990 and 1994, holds the Patriot League career steals record with 354.

## UP NEXT

American returns home to face the Golden Flashes of Kent State University. Game time is set for 4 p.m.

## HOME, SWEET HOME

AU women's basketball has accumulated a 116-78 (.598) record in the friendly confines of Bender Arena, since the facility opened its doors on Jan. 23, 1988. American has had a winning home record in 12 of the last 13 seasons, going 102-51 (.667) during that span. Last season, the Eagles racked up 10 wins against just two losses in Bender. American hosts 12 regular season home games this season. The Eagles opened up Bender in style so far this season, going 2-1 with wins over UNC Asheville and Howard.

## THAT'S THE TICKET!

American's five wins in nine games this season have all come when the Eagles shoot .400 or better. In AU's three losses -- at Loyola, at Arizona, at William & Mary and at home versus Elon -- American shot just .373, .379, .299 and .355.

## THREE-POINT THREAT

With three three-point field goals versus William & Mary on Dec. 20, senior guard **Kaitlin Schuyler** moved into second all-time on the school's career three-point field goals made list. The three treys gave her 106 in her career, surpassing 2003 graduate Maria Werries, who had 105, for second place. Schuyler would have to hit more than two three-pointers per game for the remaining 19 regular season contests to surpass the school record of 147 three-pointers made, set by Kari Gaskins between 1995 and 1999. This season, Schuyler is averaging 1.67 three-pointers made per game. Schuyler has hit 15 of her 46 attempts this season (.326), and more than half of her field goals come from outside the arc (15-of-29). For her career, she is averaging 1.26 three-pointers per game.

## PATRIOT LEAGUE PRESEASON PREDICTIONS

American has been selected by the Patriot League's coaches and sports information directors to finish second in the league. Ten-time Patriot League regular season champion Holy Cross was selected to win the league this year. The Crusaders were a near-unanimous selection to win the regular season title, with 14 out of a possible 16 first-place votes and 98 points. The Eagles were selected second with 84 points.

Meanwhile, junior forward **Chanel Hunt** was selected by the league's coaches and SIDs to the 2003-04 Preseason All-Patriot League Team. She was joined by Courtney Davidson from Navy, Katie Macfarlane from Army, Maggie Fontana from Holy Cross and Desire Almind from Bucknell. Hunt was among the league leaders last season in scoring (14.4 ppg), rebounding (7.3 rpg), assists (2.5 apg), steals (2.5 spg) and field goal percentage (.507).

## HUNT(ING) 1,000 POINTS

After nine games this season, junior forward **Chanel Hunt** has 742 career points (11.4 ppg), including 417 points last season (14.4 ppg). Hunt needs to average 14.4 ppg over the 19 remaining regular season games to reach the 274 points needed to attain 1,000 career points. Hunt is averaging 10.4 ppg so far this season. If Hunt can attain her 14.4 ppg scoring average from last season, she will score her 1,000th point on Feb. 20, 2004, at home against Holy Cross. Hunt would be just the 11th Eagle in school history to reach four-digits in scoring. Felicia Young is the school's all-time leading scorer, with 1,708 points.

## Scouting Report

**Brown:** Although the Bears are 3-6 so far this season, four of the team's losses have come by seven points or less. Brown is coming off a 57-49 victory over San Diego St. in the consolation game of the UAB Tournament in Birmingham, Ala.

The Bears are led by **Nyema Mitchell**, who leads the team in scoring and rebounding with 11.9 ppg and 6.3 rpg. Senior guard **Tanara Golston** chips in 10.2 ppg and leads the team with 46 assists (5.1 apg). **Colleen Kelly**, **Sarah Hayes** and **Holly Robertson** average 9.3, 8.4 and 7.8 ppg, respectively. As a team, the Bears shoot 38 percent, and 27.6 percent from behind the arc.

Defensively, Brown holds opponents to 39.9 percent shooting, and allows just less than 61 points per game.

The Bears go deep into their bench, with nine players averaging more than 15 minutes per game.

## DISHING THE ROCK

Senior guard **Kaitlin Schuyler** has 256 assists in her three-plus seasons at AU, good for seventh all-time. She is just seven assists from sixth-place. Schuyler passed out a career-high 83 assists (3.5 apg) in the 2001-02 season, and followed that up with 75 assists in 29 games (2.6 apg) last year. In her freshman campaign, Schuyler dished out 65 assists in 23 games (2.8 apg). For her career, Schuyler has given out 3.0 assists per game. If she continues on that pace, Schuyler has a chance to move into fourth place on the school's all-time career assists list, behind Danielle Blackburn (340), Karen Jenkins (396) and the school's all-time leader, Jody Thornton, who had 693 assists between 1983 and 1987. Schuyler leads the 2003-04 Eagles with 33 assists, including tallying seven dimes versus Mount St. Mary's. In addition, she has turned the ball over just 30 times this season.

## THREE-HEADED POINT GUARD

American has the luxury of having three players with the ability to distribute the ball. Senior guard Kaitlin Schuyler and Chanel Spriggs lead the Eagles with 33 and 30 assists, respectively. Meanwhile, junior point guard Joanna Barnes -- who had the third-most assists, with 10, in a single game last season versus Navy -- has chipped in 23 dimes this season.

## EVERYONE CONTRIBUTES

Eleven of the 13 active players on the American University roster -- junior **Tala Hadavi** is sitting out this season due to NCAA transfer rules -- have seen action in at least eight of the Eagles' nine games so far this season. Junior **Jenyce Woodruff** has become somewhat of a "super sub," averaging nearly 15 minutes per game. **Chanel Spriggs** leads the Eagles in minutes played, with Head Coach **Shann Hart** choosing to keep her senior co-captain on the floor for 301 of the 360 minutes played.

## WE PLAY, SHE STARTS

Senior shooting guard **Chanel Spriggs** has played in 64 games for American University since transferring from Div. III St. Mary's (Md.) after her freshman season (following the footsteps of Head Coach **Shann Hart**), and has started in each of those games. In addition to closing in on the school's all-time record for steals, Spriggs has scored 694 points in her two-plus seasons (10.8 ppg), hit nearly 48 percent of her shots and grabbed 320 rebounds (5.0 rpg).

## PAST SUCCESS = FUTURE SUCCESS?

If past results against the Eagles 2003-04 opponents are any indication of future performance, AU should have a successful season. The Eagles have a combined 102-51 (.667) record against the opponents on this season's schedule, and have a winning record when playing 13 of their 16 opponents which they have previously played. The Eagles records against 2003-04 opponents are as follows: Army, 4-3; Brown, 5-4; Bucknell, 6-3; Colgate, 5-1; Elon, 0-1; Holy Cross, 0-5; Howard, 8-6; Lafayette, 10-0; Lehigh, 7-2; Liberty, 4-0; Loyola (Md.), 6-2; UMBC, 5-3; UMES, 8-1; Mt. St. Mary's, 4-5; Navy, 10-7; and William & Mary, 26-11.

## AMERICAN VERSUS THE LEAGUE

As of Dec. 29, American University women's basketball is ranked in the top three of nine of 19 statistical categories the Patriot League calculates. The Eagles are the top team in the PL in scoring defense (allowing 57.4 ppg), three-point field goal percentage defense (allowing opponents to shoot just .248 from behind the arc), rebound defense (allowing opponents to grab 34.0 rpg, more than three rebounds better than the second-place team), steals (grabbing 12.88 per game) and turnover margin (with a whopping +3.75 differential between turnovers and turnovers forced). In addition, AU ranks second in the league in three-point field goal percentage (.324) and offensive rebounds (13.75 per game) and third in three-point field goals made (4.25 per game) and scoring margin (outscored opponents by 5.4 ppg)
