The Coaches

American University is coached by **Shann Hart** (Norfolk State '88), who is in her fourth season leading the Eagles, and seventh overall as a collegiate head coach. Hart has a career record of 116-86 [.574]. Hart led American to 18 wins last season, the most since the 1997-98 season. She is assisted by **Glenn Rigney** (Miami '79), **Deb Reardon** (Assumption '86), **Brian Johnson** (Drexel '98) and graduate manager **Quintina Walker** (William & Mary '02).

Kent State is coached by **Bob Lindsay** (Massachusetts '75), who is in his 15th season with the Golden Flashes. Lindsay owns a career record of 274-146 (.652), all with Kent State. Lindsay is assisted by **Lori Bodnar**, **Shawn Campbell** and **Pam Oswald**.

LAST TIME OUT

A valiant comeback effort by the American University women's basketball team against Brown Friday, from down 15 points with just over 10 minutes remaining, fell short and the Eagles lost, 61-52.

The Eagles jumped out on top of the Bears early, racing out to a 15-point lead at the 6:50 mark of the first half. AU used stifling defense to build its lead, holding Brown scoreless for nearly nine minutes, between 15:17 and 6:30, and forcing 15 first-half turnovers by the Bears. The Eagles also dominated the offensive glass – ripping down 10 offensive rebounds in the first stanza – to build up the 15-point margin.

However, the Bears' offense awakened in the last seven minutes of the first half and BU went on a 15-5 run to pull within five, 26-21, at the half.

Brown carried that momentum into the second half, holding American scoreless for the first 9:23 of the stanza, while scoring 20 points to pull ahead by 15 on two free throws by Sarah Hayes at the 10:48 mark. Overall, Brown went on a 35-5 run between 6:50 of the first half and 10:48 of the second stanza.

A three-pointer by **Angel McNatt** at the 10:37 mark helped launch the Eagles' comeback bid. McNatt hit another trey with 6:39 left to pull AU within 11, and senior guard **Kaitlin Schuyler** hit one of her three three-pointers on the day to make the score 47-39 with 5:31 left. A steal by **Kim Salem** led to a **Chanel Spriggs** fast-break layup to pull within six, and another layup by **Chanel Hunt** got the Eagles with four points at 47-43 with just over three minutes remaining.

However, an offensive rebound and a putback layup by Brown's Miranda Craigwell halted the Eagles' run. Brown then iced the game by making six-of-12 free throws in the last three minutes.

American, which falls to 5-5 on the season, was led by Schuyler's 13 points. Spriggs chipped in 11 points and five steals, while McNatt contributed 10 points off the bench. Freshman center **Kimeshia Junkins**, in her first collegiate start, had career-highs with six points and eight boards.

THE OPPONENT AND THE HISTORY

This is first ever meeting of American University and the Golden Flashes of Kent State University. Kent State enters today's contest 6-4, coming off a 70-45 win over Alabama A&M in the consolation game of the Auburn Holiday Classic in Auburn, Ala. The streak Golden Flashes have not won or lost more than two consecutive games this season. Kent State was impressive earlier in the season, losing by just seven against 24th-ranked Michigan St., 55-48, on Dec. 6, 2003.

ON THIS DATE

The Eagles defeated former Colonial Athletic Association foe UNC Wilmington, 81-69, on Jan. 4, 1998. The victory launched a five-game win streak, part of a record-setting 23-7 season, in which the Eagles made their first-ever appearance in a postseason tournament. AU lost to St. Joseph's, 77-68, in the first round of the WNIT to conclude the 1997-98 season.

UP NEXT

American hosts non-conference opponent Liberty University on Tuesday, Jan. 6, at 7 p.m. The Eagles then begin league play when they host Bucknell on Jan. 10 at 3 p.m.

HOME, SWEET HOME

AU women's basketball has accumulated a 116-78 (.598) record in the friendly confines of Bender Arena, since the facility opened its doors on Jan. 23, 1988. American has had a winning home record in 12 of the last 13 seasons, going 102-51 (.667) during that span. Last season, the Eagles racked up 10 wins against just two losses in Bender. American hosts 12 regular season home games this season. The Eagles opened up Bender in style so far this season, going 2-1 with wins over UNC Asheville and Howard.

THAT'S THE TICKET!

American's five wins this season have all come when the Eagles shoot .400 or better. In each of AU's five losses, the Eagles have a sub-.400 shooting night. The Eagles tied a season-low in their most recent loss, against Brown, shooting just 30 percent (18-of-59).

THREE-POINT THREAT

With three three-point field goals versus William & Mary on Dec. 20, senior guard **Kaitlin Schuyler** moved into second all-time on the school's career three-point field goals made list. The three treys gave her 106 in her career, surpassing 2003 graduate Maria Werries, who had 105, for second place. Schuyler would have to hit more than two three-pointers per game for the remaining 19 regular season contests to surpass the school record of 147 three-pointers made, set by Kari Gaskins between 1995 and 1999. This season, Schuyler is averaging 1.8 three-pointers made per game. Schuyler has hit 18 of her 53 attempts this season (.340), and more than half of her field goals come from outside the arc (18-of-33). For her career, she is averaging 1.3 three-pointers per game.

PATRIOT LEAGUE PRESEASON PREDICTIONS

American has been selected by the Patriot League's coaches and sports information directors to finish second in the league. Ten-time Patriot League regular season champion Holy Cross was selected to win the league this year. The Crusaders were a near-unanimous selection to win the regular season title, with 14 out of a possible 16 first-place votes and 98 points. The Eagles were selected second with 84 points.

Meanwhile, junior forward **Chanel Hunt** was selected by the league's coaches and SIDs to the 2003-04 Preseason All-Patriot League Team. She was joined by Courtney Davidson from Navy, Katie Macfarlane from Army, Maggie Fontana from Holy Cross and Desire Almind from Bucknell. Hunt was among the league leaders last season in scoring (14.4 ppg), rebounding (7.3 rpg), assists (2.5 apg), steals (2.5 spg) and field goal percentage (.507).

HUNT(ING) 1,000 POINTS

After 10 games this season, junior forward **Chanel Hunt** has 748 career points (11.3 ppg), including 417 points last season (14.4 ppg). Hunt needs to average 14.8 ppg over the 17 remaining regular season games to reach the 252 points needed to attain 1,000 career points. Hunt is averaging 9.9 ppg so far this season. If Hunt can attain her 14.4 ppg scoring average from last season, she will score her 1,000th point on Feb. 20, 2004, at home against Holy Cross. Hunt would be just the 11th Eagle in school history to reach four-digits in scoring. Felicia Young is the school's all-time leading scorer, with 1,708 points.

Scouting Report

Kent State: The streaky Golden Flashes have not won or lost more than two consecutive games this season. Kent St. enters today's contest after going 1-1 at the Auburn Holiday Classic in Auburn, Ala., losing to Northwestern St., 78-74, in the opening round and grabbing the consolation game with a 70-45 win over Alabama A&M.

The Golden Flashes rely on the twin towers of 6-6 redshirt junior center **Andrea Cszasz** and 6-1 sophomore forward **Lindsay Shearer**. Cszasz averages 14.5 ppg, 9.5 rpg and hits more than 80 percent of her free throws, while Shearer contributes 12.9 ppg and 7.3 rpg. Shearer also adds an outside threat, hitting 53 percent from outside the arc (eight-of-15). Meanwhile, 5-8 redshirt sophomore guard **Malika Willoughby** is an assist machine, passing out 65 dimes (6.5/game) on the season.

DISHING THE ROCK

Senior guard **Kaitlin Schuyler** has 259 assists in her three-plus seasons at AU, good for seventh all-time. She is just four assists from sixth-place. Schuyler passed out a career-high 83 assists (3.5 apg) in the 2001-02 season, and followed that up with 75 assists in 29 games (2.6 apg) last year. In her freshman campaign, Schuyler dished out 65 assists in 23 games (2.8 apg). For her career, Schuyler has given out 3.0 assists per game. If she continues on that pace, Schuyler has a chance to move into fourth place on the school's all-time career assists list, behind Danielle Blackburn (340), Karen Jenkins (396) and the school's all-time leader, Jody Thornton, who had 693 assists between 1983 and 1987. Schuyler leads the 2003-04 Eagles with 36 assists, including tallying seven dimes versus Mount St. Mary's.

THREE-HEADED POINT GUARD

American has the luxury of having three players with the ability to distribute the ball. Senior guard **Kaitlin Schuyler** and **Chanel Spriggs** lead the Eagles with 36 and 28 assists, respectively. Meanwhile, junior point guard **Joanna Barnes** -- who had the third-most assists, with 10, in a single game last season versus Navy -- has chipped in 23 dimes this season.

EVERYONE CONTRIBUTES

Twelve of the 13 active players on the American University roster -- junior **Tala Hadavi** is sitting out this season due to NCAA transfer rules -- have seen action in at least eight of the Eagles' 10 games so far this season. Junior **Jenyce Woodruff** has become somewhat of a "super sub," averaging nearly 15 minutes per game. **Chanel Spriggs** leads the Eagles in minutes played, with Head Coach **Shann Hart** choosing to keep her senior co-captain on the floor for 335 of the 400 minutes played. Meanwhile, senior walk-on guard **Courtney Spellacy** -- the only player not to have played in at least eight games -- has seen significant playing time as of late, including playing 10 minutes versus Brown on Jan. 2.

WE PLAY, SHE STARTS

Senior shooting guard **Chanel Spriggs** has played in 65 games for American University since transferring from Div. III St. Mary's (Md.) after her freshman season (following the footsteps of Head Coach **Shann Hart**), and has started in each of those games. In addition to closing in on the school's all-time record for steals, Spriggs has scored 705 points in her two-plus seasons (10.8 ppg), hit nearly 48 percent of her shots and grabbed 321 rebounds (4.9 rpg).

PAST SUCCESS = FUTURE SUCCESS?

If past results against the Eagles 2003-04 opponents are any indication of future performance, AU should have a successful season. The Eagles have a combined 102-51 (.667) record against the opponents on this season's schedule, and have a winning record when playing 13 of their 16 opponents which they have previously played. The Eagles records against 2003-04 opponents are as follows: Army, 4-3; Brown, 5-4; Bucknell, 6-3; Colgate, 5-1; Elon, 0-1; Holy Cross, 0-5; Howard, 8-6; Lafayette, 10-0; Lehigh, 7-2; Liberty, 4-0; Loyola (Md.), 6-2; UMBC, 5-3; UMES, 8-1; Mt. St. Mary's, 4-5; Navy, 10-7; and William & Mary, 26-11.

AMERICAN VERSUS THE LEAGUE

As of Dec. 29, American University women's basketball is ranked in the top three of nine of 19 statistical categories the Patriot League calculates. The Eagles are the top team in the PL in scoring defense (allowing 57.4 ppg), three-point field goal percentage defense (allowing opponents to shoot just .248 from behind the arc), rebound defense (allowing opponents to grab 34.0 rpg, more than three rebounds better than the second-place team), steals (grabbing 12.88 per game) and turnover margin (with a whopping +3.75 differential between turnovers and turnovers forced). In addition, AU ranks second in the league in three-point field goal percentage (.324) and offensive rebounds (13.75 per game) and third in three-point field goals made (4.25 per game) and scoring margin (outscored opponents by 5.4 ppg)
