Bucknell is coached by **Kathy Fedorjaka** (Fairfield '90), who is in her 11th season with the Bison. Fedorjaka owns a career record of 168-105 (.615), including a 101-67 (.601) record at Bucknell. Fedorjaka is assisted by **Scott Foulis**, **Michelle Simons** and **Laurie Scherer**.

AMERICAN UNIVERSITY WOMEN'S BASKETBALL



LAST TIME OUT

Joanna Barnes scored a career-high 23 points, and helped send the game into overtime, but it was not enough as the American University women's basketball team lost a double-overtime contest to Liberty University by four points, 76-72.

American trailed by as many as a dozen points in the second half, but fought back. Barnes hit a pair of free throws to bring AU to within three points with 4:46 remaining. Kaithlin Schuyler then tied things up at 48 with a three. Liberty briefly took a two-point lead and then after both teams exchanged free throws, Barnes again knotted things up from the line, sinking two shots with 1:54 left. Barnes then drove the lane and hit a twisting layup with 23 seconds remaining in regulation to give AU its first lead since the 18:19 mark of the first half. However, Kristal Tharp hit two free throws to send the game into its first overtime.

Liberty quickly built a five-point lead in OT, but again, the Eagles came back. They took a brief lead at 64-61 thanks to a three-point play by Barnes. However, Tharp was fouled shooting a three with 10 seconds left and calmly sank all three shots to send the game into a second overtime.

In the final period AU's Chanel Hunt gave the Eagles a quick lead when she buried a three just 23 second into the period, the first three-pointer in her career. After the two teams exchanged scores, Barnes gave AU a 70-69 lead off of a jumper. Schuyler pushed the lead to three after she made a layup with 2:30 remaining. Unfortunately, that was all the scoring the Eagles would do on the night. Liberty scored seven straight points to close out the game.

The Eagles had fought back all night. In the first half Liberty quickly established a seven-point lead (11-4) after making a 9-2 run in the first 5:41 of the contest. The Eagles scored six of the next seven points to close the gap to a bucket (12-10). Barnes got the mini-run going with a jumper and then Angel McNatt scored the next four points. She scored on a layup off of an assist and 20 seconds later McNatt stole the ball and went in for another score to bring AU to within two points at 12:04.

The Flames scored 14 of the next 18 points to take its largest lead of the game (26-14) at 12 points before the Eagles began to chip away at the deficit once again. Four different Eagles scored as AU closed out the half strong, eventually trailing by just seven, 30-23. Liberty's Katie Feenstra was the only player who scored in double figures for the first stanza with 11 points, adding five first-half rebounds.

Aside from the standout performance by Barnes, Kim Salem grabbed a career-high 11 rebounds. Hunt finished just one board shy of a double-double with nine rebounds and 10 points while Chanel Spriggs scored 11 points and managed six rebounds and six steals. McNatt finished with 10 points and six rebounds while Schuyler netted 11 points and dished five assists.

ON THIS DATE

The Eagles defeated former Colonial Athletic Association foe George Mason, 78-55, on Jan. 10, 1987. The win was part of the Eagles' second consecutive 20-win season, in which they finished 20-8.

UP NEXT

American faces its nearest Patriot League rival, the Navy Midshipmen, on Tuesday, Jan. 13 beginning at 7 p.m. The Eagles hold a 10-7 series record versus the Mids. However, six of Navy's wins have come at Alumni Hall in Annapolis.

THE OPPONENT AND THE HISTORY

This is the 10th meeting between the Bison of Bucknell and American University. The Eagles hold a 6-3 advantage, including a 3-1 record at Bender Arena. AU has won the last two meetings, both last season, with a 75-74 victory coming in Lewisburg, Pa. and a 72-60 triumph in Washington. Currently, Bucknell is the hottest team in the league, riding a two-game win streak entering today's contest. The Bison recently knocked off Fairleigh Dickinson University on Jan. 5, 67-65, and Iona on Jan. 6, 86-76.

SPRIGGS RANKED SECOND IN NCAA IN STEALS/GAME

As of Jan. 5, senior guard Chanel Spriggs ranked second in the National Collegiate Athletic Association's Division I in steals per game with 4.0 steals in each game which she has played. At the time of the rankings, Spriggs had nabbed 44 steals in 11 games. She was just 0.1 away from the nation's leader, April Banks of Wichita State, who had 37 steals in nine games. Spriggs, who is known for her thievery, set AU's career steals record earlier this season when she pilfered six balls from UMBC. She currently has 267 steals and continues to stretch her lead in that category every game.

KEY STAT: SHOOTING PERCENTAGE

Four of American's five wins this season have come when the Eagles shoot .400 or better. In each of AU's seven losses, the Eagles have had a sub-.400 shooting night. The Eagles' only win when shooting below 40 percent came against the University of Maryland-Baltimore County on Dec. 18, a game in which AU forced 25 Retriever turnovers and allow UMBC to shoot just 37 percent. The Eagles are currently shooting .376 as a team on the season. AU is also undefeated (5-0) when they shoot better from the field than its opponent. However, the Eagles have not won a game when their opponent has a better shooting percentage (0-7).

CHASING 1,000

After 12 games this season, junior forward Chanel Hunt has 775 career points (11.4 ppg), including 417 points last season (14.4 ppg). Hunt needs to average 15.0 ppg over the 15 remaining regular season games to reach the 225 points needed to attain 1,000 career points. Hunt is averaging 10.5 ppg so far this season, and is coming off a season-high 17 points in the loss against Kent State. If Hunt can attain her 14.4 ppg scoring average from last season, she will score her 1,000th point on Feb. 20, 2004, at home against Holy Cross. Hunt would be just the 11th Eagle in school history to reach four-digits in scoring. Felicia Young is the school's all-time leading scorer, with 1,708 points.

Meanwhile, Senior guard Chanel Spriggs is also chasing down the 1,000-point barrier, albeit in a less traditional way. The 5-7 Sunderland, Md., native played her freshman season (1999-2000) at NCAA Division III St. Mary's College of Maryland. She scored 229 points that season (8.5 ppg), and has scored 720 points in her three seasons at American, giving her 949 career points. At Spriggs' current pace (she is averaging 11.0 ppg this season), she will reach 1,000 points at Holy Cross on Jan. 25.

Scouting Report

Bucknell: The Bison have compiled a 7-6 record with the old and the new. Senior forward Desire Almind -- the old -- leads BU with 19.1 ppg and an astounding 14.9 rebounds per contest. Freshman sensation Lindsey Hollobaugh -- the new -- is second on the team in scoring, with 16.9 ppg, and rebounding, with 5.5 rpg. In the six weeks that the Patriot League's sports information directors have voted on the league Freshman of the Week award, Hollobaugh has earned top honors four times, including this past week. Almind has won PL Player of the Week two times. Almind and Hollobaugh are the Bison's only two players that have started all 13 games. Eight other players have made up the other three starting spots so far.

The Bison enter today's contest 7-6, but have won six of their last eight, including the last two over Fairleigh Dickinson and Iona.

Several players on the 2003-04 Eagles have either already broken records or have a chance to make their marks on the AU career record books. Here is a list of those players and their superlatives:

Chanel Hunt	<i>Points</i>	Has 775 points, with a chance to become just the 11th Eagle to surpass the 1,000-point barrier this season.
	<i>Rebounds</i>	Has 454 career rebounds, with a chance to break into the school's top-10. If Hunt repeats her 212 rebound performance from last season, she will finish her junior season ranked seventh in career rebounds with 582, and would have a chance of breaking the school record of 881 career rebounds, set by Mary Klima from 1994 to 1998.
	<i>Shooting Pct.</i>	Currently shooting .470 for her career, which would place her ninth on the school's all-time list. Her 174 steals are just two away from the school's all-time top 10. If Hunt replicates her 83-steal effort from last season, she will move into second all-time at AU in steals.
	<i>Steals</i>	
Kaitlin Schuyler	<i>Three-pointers Made</i>	Currently ranks second in career three-points, with 115. She has an outside shot of breaking the school record of 147, set by Kari Gaskins from 1995 to 1999. She would need to average more than two three-pointers per game for the rest of the season. In the 2003-04 season, Schuyler is averaging 1.92 three-pointers per game.
	<i>3-pt. Shooting Pct.</i>	Currently ranks 10th, hitting .285 of her attempts.
	<i>Assists</i>	Her 267 career assists puts her fifth on AU's all-time list. Will likely move into fourth place by the end of the season.

THE GAME OF HER CAREER

In the heartbreaking, 76-72, double-overtime loss to Liberty on Jan. 6, junior guard **Joanna Barnes** had perhaps the best game of her career. The 5-10 point guard chipped in a career-high 23 points and tied a career-high by making seven-of-eight free throws. Barnes tossed in a career-high eight field goals, on 20 shots, and added three rebounds, two assists and a steal in 30 minutes of action. In addition, she hit a twisting jump shot in the lane to send the game to its first overtime.
