Hart has a career record of 123-91 [.575]. Hart led American to 18 wins last season, the most since the 1997-98 season. She is assisted by **Glenn Rigney** (Miami '79), **Deb Reardon** (Assumption '86), **Brian Johnson** (Drexel '98) and graduate manager **Quintina Walker** (William & Mary '02).

Holy Cross is coached by **Bill Gibbons** (Clark '81), who is in his 19th season with the Crusaders. Gibbons owns a career record of 392-168 (.700), all at Holy Cross. Gibbons is assisted by **Catherine DiGiacinto**, **Anna Kinne** and **Brian Wilson**.

AMERICAN UNIVERSITY WOMEN'S BASKETBALL



LAST TIME OUT

Chanel Hunt scored 21 points and grabbed 10 rebounds to lead the American University women's basketball team past Lehigh University, 55-48, Saturday at Stabler Arena. With the win, the Eagles move to 7-3 in the Patriot League and maintain a share of first place in the league.

In a tight battle in which the lead changed hands eight times, Lehigh's Dawn Gorynski scored three of her team-high 16 points on a trey with 5:21 left in the game to give the Mountain Hawks a 48-46 lead. However, AU held Lehigh scoreless for the remainder of the contest and the Eagles finished off the Mountain Hawks with a 9-0 run to end the game. American started the game off slowly, hitting just two of its first seven shots, but still held a 4-2 lead at the 16:30 mark. The Eagles' defense then stiffened, forcing seven turnovers over the next seven minutes and allowing the Mountain Hawks to score just three points. At the 8:54 of the first half, AU held an 18-5 lead.

Lehigh responded with a 19-2 run to end the half. AU went one-for-15 during the run, and the Eagles trailed 24-20 at halftime. American shot just 25 percent (nine-of-36) in the first stanza.

The Mountain Hawks desperately tried to pull away from American in the early part of the second half, going up by five at 17:01 and 15:24, but the Eagles hung tight. AU chipped away at the lead, and took its first lead since the 2:00 mark in the first half on a jumper by Hunt with 14:24 left. The two teams traded the lead five times over the next nine minutes, leading up to Gorynski's three-pointer.

American shot 56 percent in the second half and held the Mountain Hawks to just 29 percent shooting in the latter period to help the Eagles eventually pull away.

Hunt's double-double was her fourth of the season. She hit eight-of-16 from the field and five-of-seven from the line. Chanel Spriggs added 10 points, a season-high seven steals, four rebounds and three assists. The three assists vaulted her into AU's top-10 all-time for career assists, with 216. In addition, Joanna Barnes added nine points and tied her career-high with 11 boards.

With wins of their own Saturday, Colgate and Holy Cross are now tied with American atop the Patriot League standings.

THE OPPONENT AND THE HISTORY

This is the seventh meeting between American University and the Crusaders of the College of the Holy Cross. AU has never defeated Holy Cross. The Crusaders defeated the Eagles earlier this season, 74-56.

ON THIS DATE

The Eagles defeated Trinity, 37-34, on Feb. 20, 1973. The win launched a three-game win streak for the Eagles, but the squad finished the season 4-5.

UP NEXT

The Eagles host Colgate on Sunday at 3 p.m. in a game that could have implications in the race for first-place in the Patriot League. Currently, American, Holy Cross and Colgate are all tied for first place with 7-3 records. Earlier this season, AU defeated Colgate in Hamilton, N.Y., on a last-second jumper by Chanel Hunt.

THREE IN A ROW?

Tonight the Eagles have a chance to win three consecutive games for the first time this season. AU has had five two-game win streaks so far this season, but has never been able to put away a third straight victory. This season is the mirror opposite of last season, when the Eagles put together one four-game, one five-game and two three-game win streaks. However, it won't be easy to capture numero tres, as AU has never beaten Holy Cross.

CRUSADER CURSE

American has not beaten Holy Cross in six tries. The Eagles dropped a 74-56 decision earlier this season. The closest AU has ever come to defeating Holy Cross was in the two teams' first meeting, when HC came away from Washington with a 67-62 win.

SPRIGGS NO. 2 IN NCAA IN STEALS PER GAME

As of Feb. 16, senior guard **Chanel Spriggs** is ranked second in the National Collegiate Athletic Association's Division I in steals per game with 3.7 steals in each game which she has played. Spriggs has currently nabbed 86 steals in 23 games. The 5-7 Sunderland, Md., native was leading the nation in steals, at 4.2 per game, earlier this season. Spriggs, who is known for her thievery, set AU's career steals record earlier this season when she pilfered six balls from UMBC. She currently has 303 steals and continues to stretch her lead in that category every game. Spriggs also holds the top two spots in the record book for steals in a single season. In 2001-02, Spriggs snagged 110 steals. She followed that season up with a 107-steal effort in 2002-03. Spriggs is currently on pace for 101steals in the regular season.

HUNT SET TO TOP THE 900-POINT BARRIER

Entering tonight's contest, junior forward **Chanel Hunt** has 899 career points in 79 career games (11.4 ppg). She is averaging a team-high 10.9 ppg this season, meaning she scores a point every three-and-two-thirds minutes. If that follows, Hunt will have 900 points by the 16:20 mark of the first stanza. The 6-0 North Carolina native has an outside shot at breaking the 1,000-point barrier this season, with four regular season games remaining and at least one game in the Patriot League Championship tournament.

DEFENSE ... DEFENSE ... DEFENSE ...

A hallmark of the AU squads under coach **Shann Hart**'s tenure has been defense, and plenty of it. The 2003-04 Eagles are no different. This year's version of the team ranks 17th in NCAA Division I in steals per game (11.9/game) and is holding its opponents to just 58.7 points per game. If the Eagles can maintain that average, they would go down as arguably the best defensive squad in school history. The 2002-03 Eagles set a school record for least points per game allowed, at 64.6, and the 2003-04 AU squad could surpass that.

Scouting Report

Holy Cross: The Crusaders feature a balanced offense, with three players averaging double-digits, led by 6-3 **Lisa Andrews**, who averages 14.7 ppg and hits 55 percent of her field goal attempts. PL Preseason First-Team pick **Maggie Fontana** is close behind, with 13.7 ppg. Fontana also leads the Crusaders with 115 assists. Sophomore point guard **Sarah Placek** -- who is from nearby Alexandria, Va. -- checks in at 10.5 ppg.

Holy Cross has proven to be a second-half team so far this season. The Crusaders have scored 660 points in first halves (28.6 points per first half) and 837 points in the second half (36.4 points per second half). However, HC has also given up 117 more points in second stanzas.

Defensively, Andrews again leads the way, swatting away 58 shots this season. She ranks first in the PL in blocked shots.

QUIET STANDOUT

Junior forward **Kim Salem** is quietly putting up solid numbers this season. The 6-1 Canadian is averaging 8.5 ppg, 5.1 rpg and is shooting a team-best 52 percent. Salem, who had started just one game in her career before this season, has started 21 of 23 games this season. Salem is also solid at the charity stripe, hitting 73 percent of her free throw attempts.

ASSAULTING THE CAREER RECORD BOOKS

Several players on the 2003-04 Eagles have either already broken records or have a chance to make their marks on the AU career record books. Here is a list of those players and their superlatives:

If Hunt repeats her 212 rebound performance from last season, she will finish her junior season ranked seventh in career rebounds with 582, and would have a chance of breaking the school record of 881 career rebounds, set by Mary Klima from 1994 to 1998.
	<i>Steals</i>	Recently cracked into the school's all-time top-10 in steals, with 195. Will move into ninth place all-time with three steals today.
Kaitlin Schuyler	<i>Three-pointers Made</i>	Currently ranks second in career three-pointers, with 129. She has an outside shot of breaking the school record of 147, set by Kari Gaskins from 1995-99. She would need to average more than three three-pointers per game for the rest of the season. In the 2003-04 season, Schuyler is averaging 1.68 three-pointers per game.
	<i>3-pt. Shooting Pct.</i>	Currently ranks 10th, hitting .286 of her attempts.
	<i>Assists</i>	Her 305 career assists puts her fourth on AU's all-time list, 35 away from third place.
Chanel Spriggs	<i>Steals</i>	Surpassed the previous record of 245 steals earlier this season vs. UMBC. Currently has 303 career steals. She is just the sixth player in Patriot League history to surpass 300 steals.
	<i>Shooting Pct.</i>	Currently shooting .445, which would place her 10th on the school list.
	<i>Assists</i>	Currently has 216 career assists, 10th all-time at AU. Needs just 15 assists to move up to seventh.

EAGLES WELCOME TRANSFER

Sophomore forward **Abby Lipskis** has joined American after transferring from the University of Rhode Island. The 6-2 Lipskis, who played her prep ball in Norfolk, Va., for Norfolk Collegiate, played in 18 games as a freshman, starting three, and averaged 1.4 ppg and 1.9 rpg. Due to NCAA transfer rules, Lipskis will not be eligible to play for AU until mid-way through the 2004-05 season. However, Lipskis has been practicing with the team and could figure to be a post presence in the Patriot League come 2005.
