**The Coaches**

American University is coached by **Shann Hart** (Norfolk State '88), who is in her fourth season leading the Eagles, and seventh overall as a collegiate head coach. Hart has a career record of 113-81 [.582]. Hart led American to 18 wins last season, the most since the 1997-98 season. She is assisted by **Glenn Rigney** (Miami '79), **Deb Reardon** (Assumption '86), **Brian Johnson** (Drexel '98) and graduate manager **Quintina Walker** (William & Mary '02).

Arizona is coached by **Joan Bonvicini** (Southern Connecticut '75), who is in her 13th season with the Wildcats. Bonvicini owns a career record of 542-212 (.719), including a 217-141 (.606) record at Arizona. Bonvicini is assisted by **Mary Ciuk**, **Kia Damon** and **Jodi Culbertson**.

## LAST TIME OUT

Five American University women's basketball players tallied double figures Wednesday night to help the Eagles capture a 72-62 win over host Mount St. Mary's.

The first half was a back-and-forth battle, in which neither team led by more than seven and the lead changed 11 times. Senior guard **Chanel Spriggs** hit a layup with two seconds remaining in the first half to send the Eagles to the locker room up two points, 27-25.

The Eagles then exploded in the first five minutes of the second stanza. A pair of jumpers by **Kim Salem** helped start a 13-4 run by the Eagles, which stretched their lead to 11.

The Mountaineers scratched their way back into the game, coming within five points with 3:49 remaining. However, **Kaitlin Schuyler** hit a layup and then stole the ball on the next possession, which led to a layup by Spriggs and helped the Eagles to regain the momentum. Mount St. Mary's came no closer than seven the remainder of the game.

Spriggs led five Eagles in double figures with 16 points, nine boards, five assists and five steals. Schuyler chipped in 15 points and seven assists, while Salem hit six-of-10 shots and finished with 13 points. **Chanel Hunt** had 12 points and 10 rebounds, her first double-double of the season. Point guard **Joanna Barnes** scored 10 points and added five assists.

## THE OPPONENT AND THE HISTORY

This is the first ever meeting between American and Arizona. The Wildcats enter this evening's contest 3-2. Arizona went 2-2 in four games last week, opening the week with a 75-65 loss against No. 16 UC Santa Barbara. The Wildcats then finished fifth in the Rainbow Wahine Classic, losing to Virginia on Nov. 28, 70-65, and then rebounding with wins against Navy (67-61) on Nov. 29 and host Hawaii (66-57) on Nov. 30. Arizona entered last week ranked 18th in the USA Today/Coaches Poll, but fell out of the rankings for the first time in more than a year.

## ON THIS DATE

The Eagles crushed future Patriot League foe Lafayette, 85-49, on Dec. 6, 1997. The win was part of a 10-game win streak to open the season, the only season in which AU was invited to a postseason tournament. The season concluded with a first-round loss to St. Joseph's in the WNIT.

## THIEVERY

With 230 career steals, senior guard **Chanel Spriggs** ranks third on the AU all-time career steals list. If she continues on her current pace -- she nabbed 110 steals in her sophomore season and 107 last year, good for sixth in the NCAA in steals per game -- Spriggs will easily break the all-time school record of 244 steals, set by Jody Thornton between 1983 and 1987. Spriggs 110 steals in the 2001-2002 season set the school's single-season record for most steals. She established new AU, Patriot League and Bender Arena records with 11 steals against Holy Cross on Jan. 26, 2003. In addition, after her 13 steals in four games this season, Spriggs is just one steal away from cracking the top-10 for career steals in Patriot League history. Lafayette's Heidi Caruso, who played for the Leopards between 1990 and 1994, holds the Patriot League career steals record with 354. Meanwhile, **Chanel Hunt** leads the Eagles this season with 15 steals. Hunt has 162 career steals, 17 steals away from the school's top-10.

# AMERICAN UNIVERSITY WOMEN'S BASKETBALL



## HOME, SWEET HOME

AU women's basketball has accumulated a 116-77 (.601) record in the friendly confines of Bender Arena, since the facility opened its doors on Jan. 23, 1988. American has had a winning home record in 12 of the last 13 seasons, going 102-51 (.667) during that span. Last season, the Eagles racked up 10 wins against just two losses in Bender. American hosts 12 regular season home games this season. The Eagles opened up Bender in style so far this season, with wins over UNC Asheville and Howard.

## FIVE IN DOUBLE FIGURES

In AU's 72-62 victory over Mount St. Mary's on Wednesday, all five starters scored in double figures, led by **Chanel Spriggs'** 16 points. The five Eagles in double figures was the first time that happened since Jan. 8, 2003, when AU defeated Lehigh, 71-67.

## PATRIOT LEAGUE PRESEASON PREDICTIONS

American has been selected by the Patriot League's coaches and sports information directors to finish second in the league. Ten-time Patriot League regular season champion Holy Cross was selected to win the league this year. The Crusaders were a near-unanimous selection to win the regular season title, with 14 out of a possible 16 first-place votes and 98 points. The Eagles were selected second with 84 points.

Meanwhile, junior forward **Chanel Hunt** was selected by the league's coaches and SIDs to the 2003-04 Preseason All-Patriot League Team. She was joined by Courtney Davidson from Navy, Katie Macfarlane from Army, Maggie Fontana from Holy Cross and Desire Almind from Bucknell. Hunt was among the league leaders last season in scoring (14.4 ppg), rebounding (7.3 rpg), assists (2.5 apg), steals (2.5 spg) and field goal percentage (.507).

## HUNT(ING) 1,000 POINTS

After three games this season, junior forward **Chanel Hunt** has 685 career points (11.4 ppg), including 417 points last season (14.4 ppg). Hunt needs to average 13 ppg over the 27 scheduled regular season games to reach the 351 points needed to attain 1,000 career points. In four games this season, Hunt is averaging 9.0 ppg. If Hunt maintains her 14.4 ppg scoring average from last season, she will score her 1,000th point on Feb. 20, 2004, at home against Holy Cross. Hunt would be just the 11th Eagle in school history to reach four-digits in scoring. Felicia Young is the school's all-time leading scorer, with 1,708 points.

## LEAGUE COMPARISONS

So far this season, the Eagles show up frequently among the league leaders in several Patriot League statistical categories. AU leads the league in rebound defense and rebounding margin, allowing just 33.2 rpg while grabbing 36.8 rpg. Meanwhile, American is third in the league in scoring offense (66.0 ppg), second in scoring defense (57.5 ppg allowed), second in scoring margin (+8.5 ppg), tied for second in field goal percentage (.448), second in field goal defense (.399) and second in three-point field goal percentage (.361).

## BALANCED SCORING

Six American players are averaging more than 5.0 ppg thus far. Senior guard **Chanel Spriggs** leads the way with 14.8 ppg, while junior forward **Kim Salem** tosses in 10.3 ppg. The remaining starters, **Chanel Hunt**, **Kaitlin Schuyler** and **Joanna Barnes** contribute 9.0 ppg, 8.3 ppg and 7.5 ppg, respectively. Senior **Angel McNatt** joins the starters with 5.3 ppg.

### Scouting Report

**Arizona:** Sophomore center **Shawntinice Polk**, the tallest player on the squad at 6-5, leads the Wildcats in points (16.4 ppg), rebounds (7.6 rpg) and blocks. Junior point guard **Dee Dee Wheeler** is second on the team in scoring, chipping in 16.2 ppg, while off-guard **Aimee Grzyb** contributes 11.4 ppg.

The Wildcats are coming off a hellish week in which they played four games in six days, losing two. However, Arizona's last game -- a 66-57 victory over host Hawaii in the Wahine Classic -- was five days ago. The two losses dropped the Wildcats out of the top-25 in the *USA Today!* Coaches Poll for the first time since Nov. 25, 2002.

Still, Arizona carries a 14-game home win streak into today's game, dating back to Nov. 30, 2002. Arizona looks to tie the school's all-time record for consecutive home wins.

## DISHING THE ROCK

Senior guard **Kaitlin Schuyler** has 240 assists in her three-plus seasons at AU, good for seventh all-time. She is just 23 assists from sixth-place. Schuyler passed out a career-high 83 assists (3.5 apg) in the 2001-02 season, and followed that up with 75 assists in 29 games (2.6 apg) last year. In her freshman campaign, Schuyler dished out 65 assists in 23 games (2.8 apg). For her career, Schuyler has given out 2.9 assists per game. If she continues on that pace, Schuyler has a chance to move into fourth place on the school's all-time career assists list, behind Danielle Blackburn (340), Karen Jenkins (396) and the school's all-time leader, Jody Thornton, who had 693 assists between 1983 and 1987. Schuyler leads to 2003-04 Eagles with 17 assists, including tallying seven dimes versus Mount St. Mary's.

## COMING ALIVE FROM BEHIND THE ARC

Although the Eagles last season were the best defensive team in school history, it is no secret that the Eagles struggled to shoot from three-point range, hitting just 25 percent of their three-point attempts. However, through AU's first four games, the Eagles are hitting more than 36 percent of their attempts from behind the arc. Leading the way is senior reserve **Angel McNatt**, who, despite being a career 20 percent three-point shooter, is hitting nearly 42 percent on the season (five-of-12). Meanwhile, **Chanel Spriggs**, who hit just one-of-10 three-point attempts last season and is a career 29 percent three-point shooter, has hit two of her four attempts so far. **Joanna Barnes** has hit two of her three attempts from behind the arc.

## EVERYONE CONTRIBUTES

Eleven of the 13 active players on the American University roster -- junior **Tala Hadavi** is sitting out this season due to NCAA transfer rules -- have seen action in all four of the Eagles' games so far this season. Junior **Jenyce Woodruff** has become somewhat of a "super sub," averaging nearly 17 minutes per game and shooting .545 (6-of-11) from the field. **Chanel Spriggs** leads the Eagles in minutes played, with Head Coach **Shann Hart** choosing to keep her senior co-captain on the floor for 137 of the 160 minutes played.

## WE PLAY, SHE STARTS

Senior shooting guard **Chanel Spriggs** has played in 59 games for American University since transferring from Div. III St. Mary's (Md.) after her freshman season (following the footsteps of Head Coach **Shann Hart**), and has started in each of those games. In addition to closing in on the school's all-time record for steals, Spriggs has scored 647 points in her two-plus seasons (11.0 ppg), hit nearly 48 percent of her shots and grabbed 292 rebounds (4.9 rpg).

## PAST SUCCESS = FUTURE SUCCESS?

If past results against the Eagles 2003-04 opponents are any indication of future performance, AU should have a successful season. The Eagles have a combined 102-51 (.667) record against the opponents on this season's schedule, and have a winning record when playing 13 of their 16 opponents which they have previously played. The Eagles records against 2003-04 opponents are as follows: Army, 4-3; Brown, 5-4; Bucknell, 6-3; Colgate, 5-1; Elon, 0-1; Holy Cross, 0-5; Howard, 8-6; Lafayette, 10-0; Lehigh, 7-2; Liberty, 4-0; Loyola (Md.), 6-2; UMBC, 5-3; UMEs, 8-1; Mt. St. Mary's, 4-5; Navy, 10-7; and William & Mary, 26-11.

## SECOND-HALF SQUAD

It has become clear through the first four games that the Eagles have the propensity to come alive in the second stanza. Never was it more obvious than the last game, when AU lit up the Mount St. Mary's Mountaineers for 45 points in the last half. In the second halves of each of the Eagles' first four games, they have scored 25, 38, 36 and 45 points, after scoring 27, 43, 23 and 27 in each of the first 20 minutes, respectively. As a result, the Eagles have experienced several close games, especially in the loss against Loyola, when AU trailed by 24 points with 12 minutes remaining. American rallied back to pull within two with 1:05 remaining, but eventually fell by five points, 64-59.
