Hart has a career record of 114-83 [.579]. Hart led American to 18 wins last season, the most since the 1997-98 season. She is assisted by **Glenn Rigney** (Miami '79), **Deb Reardon** (Assumption '86), **Brian Johnson** (Drexel '98) and graduate manager **Quintina Walker** (William & Mary '02).

Utah State is coached by **Raegan Scott-Pebley** (Colorado '97), who is in her first season with the Aggies. Scott-Pebley owns a career record of 0-3 (.000), all with the Aggies. Scott-Pebley is assisted by **Tricia Bader Binford**, **John Bartleson** and **Bradley Dance**.

# AMERICAN UNIVERSITY WOMEN'S BASKETBALL



## LAST TIME OUT

Despite a career-high 14 points from reserve guard **Angel Jordan** and a second consecutive double-double by **Chanel Hunt**, the Eagles on Saturday fell to No. 25 Arizona, 75-63, in the first round of the Fiesta Bowl Classic hosted by the University of Arizona.

With three minutes remaining in the first half, American had whittled what was a nine-point lead at the 9:22 mark down to just three points, 27-24. However, the Wildcats forced three Eagle turnovers and converted them into two layups to grab a 31-24 halftime lead.

Arizona then opened the second stanza with a 22-8 run over the first seven minutes to take a commanding lead, 53-32. The Wildcats one-two inside combination of 6-5 All-American Shawntinice Polk and 6-2 Danielle Adefeso combined for 16 of the 22 points. Overall, Arizona used a 22-8 advantage in points in the paint in the second half to control the game.

The Eagles made a slight run, beginning at the 9:37 mark of the second half. With AU down 28, the Eagles got within 14 with just over four minutes remaining, but another layup and a free throw by Polk quashed any hope of a comeback for American.

Jordan led the Eagles with 14 points on five-of-six shooting, including four-of-five behind the arc, in just nine minutes of action. Hunt tallied 13 points and 12 boards, while senior guard **Kaitlin Schuyler** contributed 13 points.

The Wildcats were led by Polk, who scored 18 points and added 10 rebounds, and Adefeso, who tallied 13 points and also grabbed 10 caroms. The win was the 15th straight home victory for Arizona, which sets a school record.

## THE OPPONENT AND THE HISTORY

This is the first ever meeting between American and Utah State. The Aggies enter this evening's contest 0-3, with their losses coming against Southern Utah, Montana State and the University of Massachusetts.

## ON THIS DATE

The Eagles defeated Towson State, 73-58, on Dec. 7, 1985. The win was the third in a four-game win streak, part of AU's first-ever 20-win season. American finished that season 20-7, but ended it in heartbreaking fashion with a one-point loss to East Carolina in the second round of the Colonial Athletic Association championship tournament.

## THIEVERY

With 234 career steals, senior guard **Chanel Spriggs** ranks second on the AU all-time career steals list, just 10 away from first place. If she continues on her current pace Spriggs will easily break the all-time school record of 244 steals, set by Jody Thornton between 1983 and 1987. Spriggs 110 steals in the 2001-2002 season set the school's single-season record for most steals. She established new AU, Patriot League and Bender Arena records with 11 steals against Holy Cross on Jan. 26, 2003. In addition, after her 17 steals in five games this season, Spriggs cracked into the top-10 for career steals in Patriot League history. Lafayette's Heidi Caruso, who played for the Leopards between 1990 and 1994, holds the Patriot League career steals record with 354. Meanwhile, **Chanel Hunt** leads the Eagles this season with 18 steals. Hunt has 163 career steals, 16 steals away from the school's top-10.

## UP NEXT

American faces the University of Maryland-Baltimore County on Dec. 18. Game time is set for 7 p.m.

## HOME, SWEET HOME

AU women's basketball has accumulated a 116-77 (.601) record in the friendly confines of Bender Arena, since the facility opened its doors on Jan. 23, 1988. American has had a winning home record in 12 of the last 13 seasons, going 102-51 (.667) during that span. Last season, the Eagles racked up 10 wins against just two losses in Bender. American hosts 12 regular season home games this season. The Eagles opened up Bender in style so far this season, with wins over UNC Asheville and Howard.

## FIVE IN DOUBLE FIGURES

In AU's 72-62 victory over Mount St. Mary's on Wednesday, all five starters scored in double figures, led by **Chanel Spriggs'** 16 points. The five Eagles in double figures was the first time that happened since Jan. 8, 2003, when AU defeated Lehigh, 71-67.

## PATRIOT LEAGUE PRESEASON PREDICTIONS

American has been selected by the Patriot League's coaches and sports information directors to finish second in the league. Ten-time Patriot League regular season champion Holy Cross was selected to win the league this year. The Crusaders were a near-unanimous selection to win the regular season title, with 14 out of a possible 16 first-place votes and 98 points. The Eagles were selected second with 84 points.

Meanwhile, junior forward **Chanel Hunt** was selected by the league's coaches and SIDs to the 2003-04 Preseason All-Patriot League Team. She was joined by Courtney Davidson from Navy, Katie Macfarlane from Army, Maggie Fontana from Holy Cross and Desire Almind from Bucknell. Hunt was among the league leaders last season in scoring (14.4 ppg), rebounding (7.3 rpg), assists (2.5 apg), steals (2.5 spg) and field goal percentage (.507).

## HUNT(ING) 1,000 POINTS

After five games this season, junior forward **Chanel Hunt** has 698 career points (11.4 ppg), including 417 points last season (14.4 ppg). Hunt needs to average 13 ppg over the 27 scheduled regular season games to reach the 351 points needed to attain 1,000 career points. In five games this season, Hunt is averaging 9.0 ppg. If Hunt maintains her 14.4 ppg scoring average from last season, she will score her 1,000th point on Feb. 20, 2004, at home against Holy Cross. Hunt would be just the 11th Eagle in school history to reach four-digits in scoring. Felicia Young is the school's all-time leading scorer, with 1,708 points.

## LEAGUE COMPARISONS

So far this season, the Eagles show up frequently among the league leaders in several Patriot League statistical categories. AU leads the league in rebound defense and rebounding margin, allowing just 33.2 rpg while grabbing 36.8 rpg. Meanwhile, American is third in the league in scoring offense (66.0 ppg), second in scoring defense (57.5 ppg allowed), second in scoring margin (+8.5 ppg), tied for second in field goal percentage (.448), second in field goal defense (.399) and second in three-point field goal percentage (.361).

## BALANCED SCORING

Five American players are averaging more than 5.0 ppg thus far. Senior guard **Chanel Spriggs** leads the way with 12.4 ppg, while junior forward **Kim Salem** tosses in 9.8 ppg. The remaining starters, **Chanel Hunt**, **Kaitlin Schuyler** and **Joanna Barnes** contribute 9.8 ppg, 7.7 ppg and 5.7 ppg, respectively.

## Scouting Report

**Utah State:** This is the first season the Aggies have sponsored women's basketball since the 1986-87 season. Utah St. has started this season 0-3, so it is still looking for its first win in nearly 16 years. Freshman point guard **Christine Zdenek** leads the Aggies in scoring, tossing in 11.0 ppg, while dishing out 0.7 assists per contest. Sophomore center **Ali Aird**, the tallest Aggie at 6-3, contributes 10.7 ppg and 6.3 rpg and is shooting nearly 63 percent from the field. **Ann-Marie Torp** and **Brittany Tressler** chip in 7.7 ppg and 5.7 ppg, respectively.

The Aggies are the second youngest NCAA Div. I women's basketball team in the nation, at 18.9 years on average. Utah State features nine freshman, three sophomores, one junior and no seniors. Just five Aggies have previous collegiate basketball experience before this season.

## DISHING THE ROCK

Senior guard **Kaitlin Schuyler** has 242 assists in her three-plus seasons at AU, good for seventh all-time. She is just 21 assists from sixth-place. Schuyler passed out a career-high 83 assists (3.5 apg) in the 2001-02 season, and followed that up with 75 assists in 29 games (2.6 apg) last year. In her freshman campaign, Schuyler dished out 65 assists in 23 games (2.8 apg). For her career, Schuyler has given out 2.9 assists per game. If she continues on that pace, Schuyler has a chance to move into fourth place on the school's all-time career assists list, behind Danielle Blackburn (340), Karen Jenkins (396) and the school's all-time leader, Jody Thornton, who had 693 assists between 1983 and 1987. Schuyler leads to 2003-04 Eagles with 17 assists, including tallying seven dimes versus Mount St. Mary's.

## COMING ALIVE FROM BEHIND THE ARC

Although the Eagles last season were the best defensive team in school history, it is no secret that the Eagles struggled to shoot from three-point range, hitting just 25 percent of their three-point attempts. However, through AU's first five games, the Eagles are hitting more than 35 percent of their attempts from behind the arc. Leading the way is senior reserve **Angel McNatt**, who, despite being a career 20 percent three-point shooter, is hitting nearly 42 percent on the season (five-of-12). Meanwhile, **Chanel Spriggs**, who hit just one-of-10 three-point attempts last season and is a career 29 percent three-point shooter, has hit two of her five attempts so far. **Joanna Barnes** has hit two of her six attempts from behind the arc.

## EVERYONE CONTRIBUTES

Eleven of the 13 active players on the American University roster -- junior **Tala Hadavi** is sitting out this season due to NCAA transfer rules -- have seen action in all five of the Eagles' games so far this season. Junior **Jenyce Woodruff** has become somewhat of a "super sub," averaging nearly 17 minutes per game and shooting .545 (6-of-11) from the field. **Chanel Spriggs** leads the Eagles in minutes played, with Head Coach **Shann Hart** choosing to keep her senior co-captain on the floor for 137 of the 160 minutes played.

## WE PLAY, SHE STARTS

Senior shooting guard **Chanel Spriggs** has played in 60 games for American University since transferring from Div. III St. Mary's (Md.) after her freshman season (following the footsteps of Head Coach **Shann Hart**), and has started in each of those games. In addition to closing in on the school's all-time record for steals, Spriggs has scored 650 points in her two-plus seasons (11.0 ppg), hit nearly 48 percent of her shots and grabbed 293 rebounds (4.9 rpg).

## PAST SUCCESS = FUTURE SUCCESS?

If past results against the Eagles 2003-04 opponents are any indication of future performance, AU should have a successful season. The Eagles have a combined 102-51 (.667) record against the opponents on this season's schedule, and have a winning record when playing 13 of their 16 opponents which they have previously played. The Eagles records against 2003-04 opponents are as follows: Army, 4-3; Brown, 5-4; Bucknell, 6-3; Colgate, 5-1; Elon, 0-1; Holy Cross, 0-5; Howard, 8-6; Lafayette, 10-0; Lehigh, 7-2; Liberty, 4-0; Loyola (Md.), 6-2; UMBC, 5-3; UMEs, 8-1; Mt. St. Mary's, 4-5; Navy, 10-7; and William & Mary, 26-11.

## SECOND-HALF SQUAD

It has become clear through the first five games that the Eagles have the propensity to come alive in the second stanza. Never was it more obvious than the last game, when AU lit up the Arizona Wildcats for 39 points in the second stanza. In the second halves of each of the Eagles' first five games, they have scored 25, 38, 36, 45 and 39 points, after scoring 27, 43, 23, 27 and 24 points in each of the first 20 minutes, respectively. As a result, the Eagles have experienced several close games, especially in the loss against Loyola, when AU trailed by 24 points with 12 minutes remaining. American rallied back to pull within two with 1:05 remaining, but eventually fell by five points, 64-59.
