NOTE: Unless otherwise noted, all programs require: Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university; **3.0 GPA** in last 60 hours (90 quarter hours) of undergraduate work; **scores from the GRE General Aptitude test; two recommendation letters;** and for international students whose first language is not English, a **TOEFL score** of 600 paper/250 computer/100 IBT or an IELTS score of 7. Application **deadline** for merit awards & fellowships is **February 1**, unless otherwise noted.
