1. Elections- review of constitutional changes in case of tie; there were no objections to the new changes, but a vote was not held. Voting will be done via email.
2. Conference Funding- the CAS GSC fund will start in the Fall of 2010. The attached document (see below) outlines the changes to the constitution and bylaws. This was not voted upon tonight.
 - a. Concerns were raised from various departments concerning deadlines. In particular, concerns were about conferences attended after the deadlines for submission. It was suggested that students apply for conference funding for conferences that took place up to 180 days prior to their application.
 - b. Tara also raised the point that these awards could be attached to the Mellon award next year.
 - c. It was also suggested that the Bylaws stipulate that the student receiving the award must be enrolled as a CAS American University Student at the time the conference took place.
 - d. It was suggested that the bylaws for the conference funding will be reviewed yearly and changed only by 2/3 majority vote
