## **Job Description:**

Research assistants will provide data coding and analysis support for a CLALS project examining the household contexts and integration experiences of newcomer Central American youth in the Washington, DC metropolitan area. Under the supervision of CLALS staff and faculty in Sociology and Psychology, student assistants will be responsible for coding Spanish-language interviews in NVivo.

Candidates must be a student in good standing in one of American University's undergraduate or graduate programs. Preference will be given to candidates who are studying fields related to Latin America and Latinos in the U.S. and have strong Spanish-language skills. Candidates should be familiar with social scientific methodologies, efficient with qualitative data analysis software, and able to independently execute project-specific tasks. Specific experience with NVivo is desirable.
