

FALL 2013 TRAINING COURSE FOR FACULTY:

Online Learning/Hybrids | September 23rd – October 18th

This is a four week training course for faculty interested in online or hybrid modes of teaching. The course is set up as a hybrid where teaching related discussions are held online in an asynchronous format and technology training is face-to-face. The teaching portion covers best pedagogy practices, re-inventing your syllabus, and effective course design. It is held online to capture the spirit of online discourse and instruction. The face-to-face sessions cover key technology tools including Blackboard, Panopto, Collaborate, and social media platforms such as Facebook or Wordpress.

Face-to-face training is scheduled for Wednesdays (9/25, 10/2, 10/9 and 10/16 at 10:30 to noon) in the CTRL Lab (Hurst 202). Online sessions run throughout the course (starting each Monday) with topics changing on a weekly basis. A fifth week is set aside for peer review of faculty outputs.
