

Part III All students must be able to demonstrate financial ability to pay for their academic and living expenses before being issued an immigration document. See ISS web site at http://www.american.edu/ocl/iss/applying_au/costs.html (under "Prospective Students") for program costs.

All financial documents must show *available funds* and must be *dated within the past three months* in order to be considered valid. Appropriate documents reflecting financial ability include, but are not limited to the following:

- Official Bank Statement, stamped and signed by a bank official (no more than 3 months old)
- Account summary or summary of liquid assets (no more than 3 months old)
- An individual sponsor who is a **U.S. citizen or U.S. Permanent Resident** must submit an I-134 Affidavit of Support (at www.immigration.gov, under Forms) with financial documents
- An individual sponsor who is **not** a US citizen or U.S. Permanent Resident must submit a notarized letter of sponsorship (including duration, amount, and nature of sponsorship) with financial documents
- Scholarship letter from sponsoring organization outlining dates, amount, and terms of sponsorship
- American University scholarship or graduate merit award letter

Dependent Information:

The university estimates the additional cost of supporting a **spouse is U.S.\$5,500** per year and the additional cost for **each child is U.S.\$4,000**.
