

Student Government Civic Engagement Scholarship Application Form

The purpose of the Student Government Civic Engagement Scholarship is to recognize American University Undergraduate students who perform DC or local community and campus service activities and make significant contributions to the campus community. The amount to be awarded will be \$1,000 per semester or \$2,000 for the academic year. Past awardees are eligible to apply for these funds in subsequent years at the University, provided they still meet the requirements for the scholarship.

In order to apply, applicants must:

- 1. Be in good academic standing with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 and be full time matriculated undergraduate student.
- 2. Demonstrate a vigorous commitment to the city and the people of Washington, DC during their time at American University while making significant contributions to the campus community.
- 3. Be a student with financial need. Preference will be given to Pell Grant eligible students and students with a household income of \$60,000 or less, but all students, regardless of financial aid status, are encouraged to apply.
- 4. Not hold an elected or appointed position in Student Government. Future involvement in the Student Government is not restricted. Involvement in Student Government, however, will not be considered of recipients who are re-applying for the scholarship.
