



How to use EngageNet?

What is EngageNet

EngageNet is an online application system that allows the Center for Community Engagement & Service staff to track student involvement, program performance, partner requests, and faculty involvement. There are three user portals Student, Partner and Faculty. Each portal allows applicants and other participants to track requirements and include self-service tools such as the message center, FAQ and profile manager.

There are **two steps** to the EngageNet Application process.

1. Creating a Student Interest Profile.
2. Applying to the CCES Opportunity.
