

Amendments Approved by the Faculty Senate; November 5, 2014

Amendment I

Rationale: Proposed change in the regulation should read: **Students who are dismissed with a GPA lower than 1.0 will not be considered for re-admission.** A student applying for readmission may still request that the Office of Admissions refer their request for readmission to the appropriate academic advisor for a petition for an exception to this regulation: *Based on a compelling rationale, an appeal may be made with respect to a specific undergraduate academic regulation by an undergraduate student or faculty member. Such an appeal should be directed in writing to the student's academic advisor.*

5.8. Academic Probation and Dismissal (Fourth Paragraph- change underlined in blue)

The university will dismiss immediately students whose cumulative GPA, after attempting or completing 24 credits (excluding courses in which the recorded grade is W, I, or IP), falls below 1.0 (D). Students who are dismissed with a GPA lower than 1.0 will not be considered for re-admission.
