Bruce J. Dickson is associate professor of political science and international affairs at the George Washington University. His research and teaching focus on political dynamics in China and Taiwan. His current research examines the political consequences of economic reform in China. His books include *Red Capitalists in China: The Party, Private Entrepreneurs, and Prospects for Political Change* (Cambridge University Press, 2003), *Democratization in China and Taiwan: The Adaptability of Leninist Parties* (Oxford University Press, 1998). His articles have appeared in *Asian Survey*, *Comparative Politics*, *Comparative Political Studies*, and *Political Science Quarterly*. He is also the associate editor of the journal *Problems of Post-Communism*. He received his Ph.D. from the University of Michigan in 1994.
