The Center for North American Studies is now offering an Annual David Stemper Fellowship in North American Studies in memory of a former Associate Director of the Center. Undergraduates and graduates from American University are eligible to apply for a \$1,000 grant to further their understanding of the relationship among Mexico, Canada, and the United States and the future challenges faced by the continent. Fellows will be expected to attend at least two events on North America and to assist in their preparation if they are organized by the Center for North American Studies. Fellows might use the funds for travel to Canada and/or Mexico.

Applications for the fellowship should include a curriculum vitae, a one-page proposal of a research project regarding North America, and a letter explaining the student's interest and background related to North America. Students who are selected as Fellows need to write a 15-page (single-space) paper, to be submitted to the **SIS Journal of International Service** or another journal on a topic of contemporary or future importance in North America. The paper will be due on July 1, 2012. It can be based on a paper prepared for a class, but it would need to be substantially revised.
