## 6. Public Management

Students who wish to combine their study of public policy with a deeper understanding of public administration have the opportunity to take a selection of management courses from the MPA degree. Such courses amplify lessons contained in the required MPP course on Organizational Analysis by examining issues that affect the implementation of public policies. Professors Robert Durant, Jocelyn Johnston, Howard McCurdy, and David Pitts advise students on this specialization.
