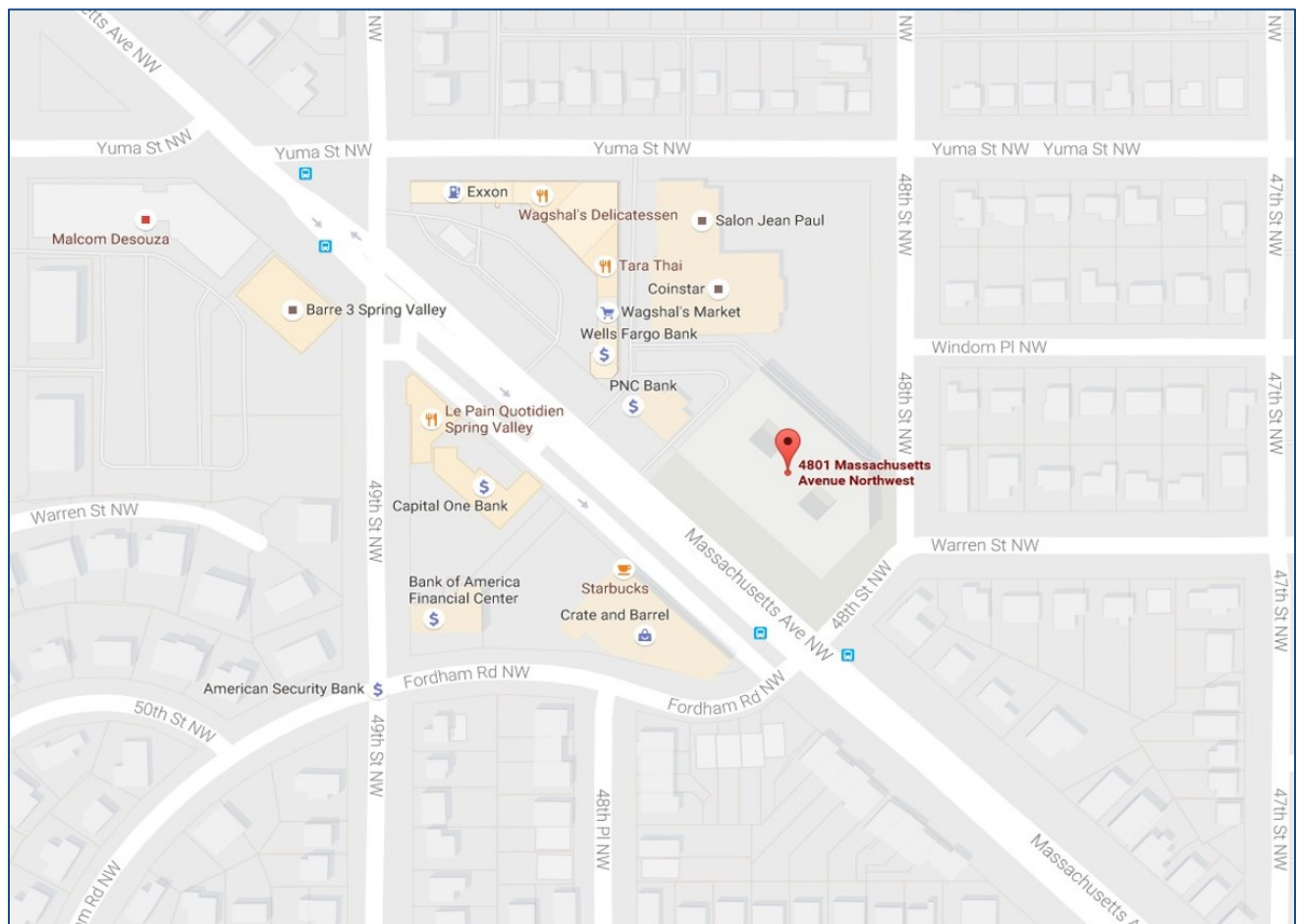

Public Transportation

American University encourages students to use Metro trains and buses. AU operates a free shuttle service for its students, faculty, staff, and visitors between Main Campus, Spring Valley and the Tenleytown-AU Metro station. Access for students with disabilities is available.

Key students traveling to the Key Executive Leadership Programs' offices and classrooms in the Spring Valley building should take the Red Route when using the American University Shuttle Service. The shuttle ride will last about 10-12 minutes. When exiting the shuttle, head down the hill and right on Massachusetts Avenue to enter the front of the Spring Valley Building, 4801 Massachusetts Avenue NW.



The shuttle runs on a continuous loop, departing approximately every fifteen minutes. You need no special pass to ride. The shuttle will then be about a 10-minute ride to campus.

**DAILY SCHEDULE - 7:15 AM – 7:00 PM MONDAY – FRIDAY FREQUENCY:
EVERY 15-25 MINUTE FROM 7:15 AM - 7:00 PM**

- First shuttle Leaves Metro at 7:15AM

- First Shuttle Leaves Spring Valley Building 7:30AM
- Last shuttle in the evening Leaves Spring Valley Building at 7:00PM
- Last shuttle in the evening Leaves Metro at 6:45PM

An Express Red Route shuttle has been added for peak commuting periods that will run every 15 minutes between 8 – 10 a.m. and 4 – 6:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. The express service will stop only at three locations – Metro, Katzen, and Spring Valley Building.

Schedules can also be obtained on the shuttle buses or by calling (202) 885-3111. To find out if the shuttle is operating during inclement weather, call (202) 885-1100.

Parking at the Spring Valley Building

A parking garage is available underneath the Spring Valley Building, 4801 Massachusetts Avenue NW. Parking regulations are enforced at all times. Violators are subject to citation, vehicle immobilization, tow and/or conduct referral.

Parking in the Spring Valley Building garage is \$2.00/hr and can be purchased at the kiosk by the elevators.

Parking and AU's Good Neighbor Policy

This requirement is in accordance with Washington, D.C., regulations and with the university's Good Neighbor Policy and is enforced year-round.

Vehicles parked illegally on campus or on the residential streets surrounding main campus will be ticketed. In the event a student receives a parking ticket, the student is responsible for paying that ticket in a timely fashion. If you believe that you have been unfairly assessed a parking ticket while parked on University property, you should contact your advisor, who will in turn contact the University's traffic enforcement division on the student's behalf.
