## If you answered "Yes" to any of these questions, then WeLead is the program for you!

WeLead, a bipartisan leadership training program run by the Women & Politics Institute at American University, works to increase the number of women working in politics and running for office. We empower young women, ignite their passions, and prepare them to succeed in politics and public service. WeLead graduates are employed in the White House and Congress, as well as at campaign consulting firms, lobbying firms, and non-profit organizations.

We target young women and conduct workshops that focus on campaigns and elections, communications and messaging, government relations, fundraising and development, and professional development. These sessions provide WeLeaders with opportunities to network and socialize with each other and with prominent women in politics and public service. The Women & Politics Institute is a non-profit organization, and participation in WeLead is free of charge for accepted applicants.

**Please note:** In order to qualify for the program, you must be between 21 and 27 years of age. In addition, you must be available to attend the program *in its entirety*. We will begin with an orientation dinner on Friday, February 24<sup>th</sup> from 6 PM – 9 PM. The two-day intensive training will then be conducted on Saturday, February 25<sup>th</sup> and Sunday, February 26<sup>th</sup>, from 9 AM – 6 PM each day. All sessions will be held in the Founders Room, School of International Service at American University. \*Please hold March 10<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> in case of inclement weather from February 24-26<sup>th</sup>.
