Students may request to transfer credit for courses taken prior to admission to the doctoral program. In no case may graduate credit be given for coursework designated as solely undergraduate by the institution where the coursework was completed. Proposed transfer courses must have been completed with a grade of B (3.00) or better and must have been completed no earlier than 5 years prior to the beginning of the semester in which the student is admitted to the program. Transfer credits must be approved by the student's Graduate Program Director during their first semester of study and be included in the student's Program of Study plan. Students must give the Graduate Program Director an official transcript from the institution at which the proposed course(s) was completed, as well as a syllabus for each course requested for transfer. Transfer credit will appear on the student's transcript, but grades from approved transferred courses at other institutions will not be counted in the student's AU cumulative GPA. Students can request a transfer of up to 18 credits, which could potentially reduce time to completion by as much as one year.
