## PROFILES

### AMERICAN UNIVERSITY

American University is an independent, coeducational university. It was chartered by an Act of Congress in 1893 as a Methodist Church–related institution. Our cosmopolitan, multicultural campus enrolls more than 14,000 students in undergraduate, master’s, doctoral, and professional degree programs. The university attracts students from all 50 states, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico and the territories, and more than 130 countries.

The university offers a wide range of undergraduate and graduate programs under its eight major divisions: College of Arts and Sciences, Kogod School of Business, School of Communication, School of Education, School of International Service, School of Public Affairs, Washington College of Law, and Professional Studies.

Our nationally and internationally acclaimed faculty are committed to excellence in scholarship and teaching of our diverse and talented student body. American University’s academic programs are grounded in the arts and sciences and connected to the extraordinary

cultural, public affairs, legal, business, international, and communication resources of Washington, DC.

Academic offerings consist of over 80 bachelor’s, approximately 95 master’s, and 11 doctoral degrees, plus the Washington College of Law’s JD, MLS, LLM, and SJD programs, and a host of certificate and nondegree programs.

Each semester students from around the world participate in American University’s Washington Semester Program, AU Abroad, and Abroad at AU.

Annually more than 400 students participate in AU’s Accelerator and American Collegiate programs, which offer curricula tailored to international students and provide support, training, and cultural orientation to help students adjust to AU and the United States.

AU will continue to build on these strengths to advance a distinctive, globally oriented university dedicated to academic excellence and preparing students for leadership in a complex international society.

### WASHINGTON COLLEGE OF LAW

Washington College of Law (WCL) is an institution with a unique heritage. It was founded in 1896 by two pioneering women, Ellen Spencer Mussey and Emma Gillett, at a time when women were generally excluded from the legal profession. WCL’s founding mothers believed that knowledge of the law was essential to achieving gender equality. Their determination led to the establishment of the first law school founded by women. Mussey and Gillett’s belief in the power of knowledge generally, and in the importance of legal knowledge particularly, continues to inspire an institution committed to excellence in legal education.

Today, WCL remains true to the pioneering spirit of its founders, recognizing the capacity of law to address the most important issues facing the nation and the world. WCL is committed to providing excellent teaching and student-centered education, to emphasizing the values of experiential learning and broad perspectives on the rule of law, to promoting and disseminating pathbreaking faculty scholarship, and to breaking down barriers

and building new relationships, both internally and externally, at home and abroad.

In 2016, the law school moved to its new Tenleytown campus—a state-of-the-art center of legal education built, in every way, to help students meet their educational goals—located one block from the Metro.

WCL’s vibrant JD program is complemented by an SJD program and master of laws programs in advocacy, intellectual property, international human rights and humanitarian law, international legal studies, and law and government. Together, they bring 200 lawyers from more than 60 countries to WCL, adding a wealth of backgrounds and experiences to our diverse community.

WCL also boasts a growing master of legal studies program, designed for non-lawyer professionals who have law-related responsibilities and understand the law’s important influence on their daily job functions and community at large.

## COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER

### THE HONORABLE KETANJI BROWN JACKSON

Doctor of Laws

Ketanji Brown Jackson was born in Washington, DC, on September 14, 1970. She married Patrick Jackson in 1996, and they have two daughters. Jackson received an AB, *magna cum laude*, from Harvard University's Radcliffe College in 1992, and a JD, *cum laude*, from Harvard Law School in 1996. She served as a law clerk for Judge Patti B. Saris of the US District Court for the District of Massachusetts from 1996 to 1997, Judge Bruce M. Selya of the US Court of Appeals for the First Circuit from 1997 to 1998, and Justice Stephen G. Breyer of the Supreme Court of the United States during the 1999 term. After three years in private practice, Jackson worked as an attorney at the US Sentencing Commission from 2003 to 2005. From 2005 to 2007, she served as

an assistant federal public defender in Washington, DC, and from 2007 to 2010, she was in private practice. She served as a vice chair and commissioner on the US Sentencing Commission from 2010 to 2014. In 2012, President Obama nominated Jackson to the US District Court for the District of Columbia, where she served from 2013 to 2021. She was appointed to the Defender Services Committee of the Judicial Conference of the United States in 2017, and the Supreme Court Fellows Commission in 2019. President Biden appointed her to the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit in 2021 and then nominated her as an associate justice of the Supreme Court, where Jackson took her seat on June 30, 2022.

## DEGREE CANDIDATES JOINING THE ARMED FORCES

Graduating students who are serving, have served, or will serve after graduation receive a red, white, and blue cord to wear over their gown, courtesy of the Student Veterans of America (AU Chapter).
