

- FORMAL ANC APPROVAL PRIOR TO ZC HEARING.

DRAFT COMMUNITY OUTREACH AND ENGAGEMENT

- Dec: Reach out to neighbors along University Avenue in-person (December 15).
 - Knock on doors, leave business card with Maria Barry information.
- Jan: Create comment portal on Campus Plan website with Meltzer Center/SCAN info.
 - Begin soliciting Meltzer Center feedback 1st Week of January.
 - Upload Meltzer Center materials as available (PE Mature Renderings, PE App Package).
- Jan: Mail a letter/flyer to University Ave neighbors and the surrounding area (about 100 households).
 - Share Meltzer Center info; invite AUNP participation, open house attendance; reference Campus Plan website
- Jan: Send Meltzer Center article to neighborhood list (links to website and Jan. Open House; "How to Join AUNP").
- Jan/Feb/March: Host a series of "open houses" on Meltzer Center for community education and discussion.

2021 CAMPUS PLAN - EXISTING AND PROPOSED USES








EXHIBIT J PROPOSED BUILDING USES

EXAMPLES OF DRAFT DESIGN PRINCIPLES IMPACTING NEIGHBOR EXPERIENCE

- Maintain landscape as the primary experience of the site from University Avenue.
- Present welcoming "face" to all sides.
- Minimize noise and glazing facing the adjacent neighborhood.
- Plan for primary entry space on the campus side.
- Allow for optimal indoor/outdoor connections.
- Adapt existing service road to accommodate the pedestrian experience.
- Provide service locations that are convenient and not visually obtrusive.
- Respect property line offsets from University Avenue per approved campus plan.
- Design to optimize natural light and ventilation.
- Seek a compact and efficient footprint to optimize value of the project.







MELTZER CENTER/SCAN PROJECT AREA – DIAGRAMMATIC SITE SECTION @ UNIV. AVE.







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
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

EXISTING CAMPUS AND 2021 CAMPUS PLAN








