Review Student Conduct Reports

REPORTS:

For the period of September 1 – December 1, 2022, the Office of the Dean of Students has received 8 reports of disruptive off-campus behavior.

5 reports regarding single family homes

3 – Spring Valley

2 – AU Park

3 report from apartment/condo communities

2 - Berkshires

1 – McLean Gardens

7 complaints were regarding noise and/or large gatherings

1 complaint was regarding outdoor gathering/noise in a public place

During the same period last year, there were 13 reports.

ACTION:

- 3 reports were resolved through a meeting with the Dean of Students
- 2 reports lacked sufficient information or were complaints where students were not able to be identified
- 1 report was referred to Student Conduct for adjudication
- 1 report was referred to the WCL Dean of Students for resolution under their protocol/Honor Code
- 1 report was referred to building/property management for resolution
