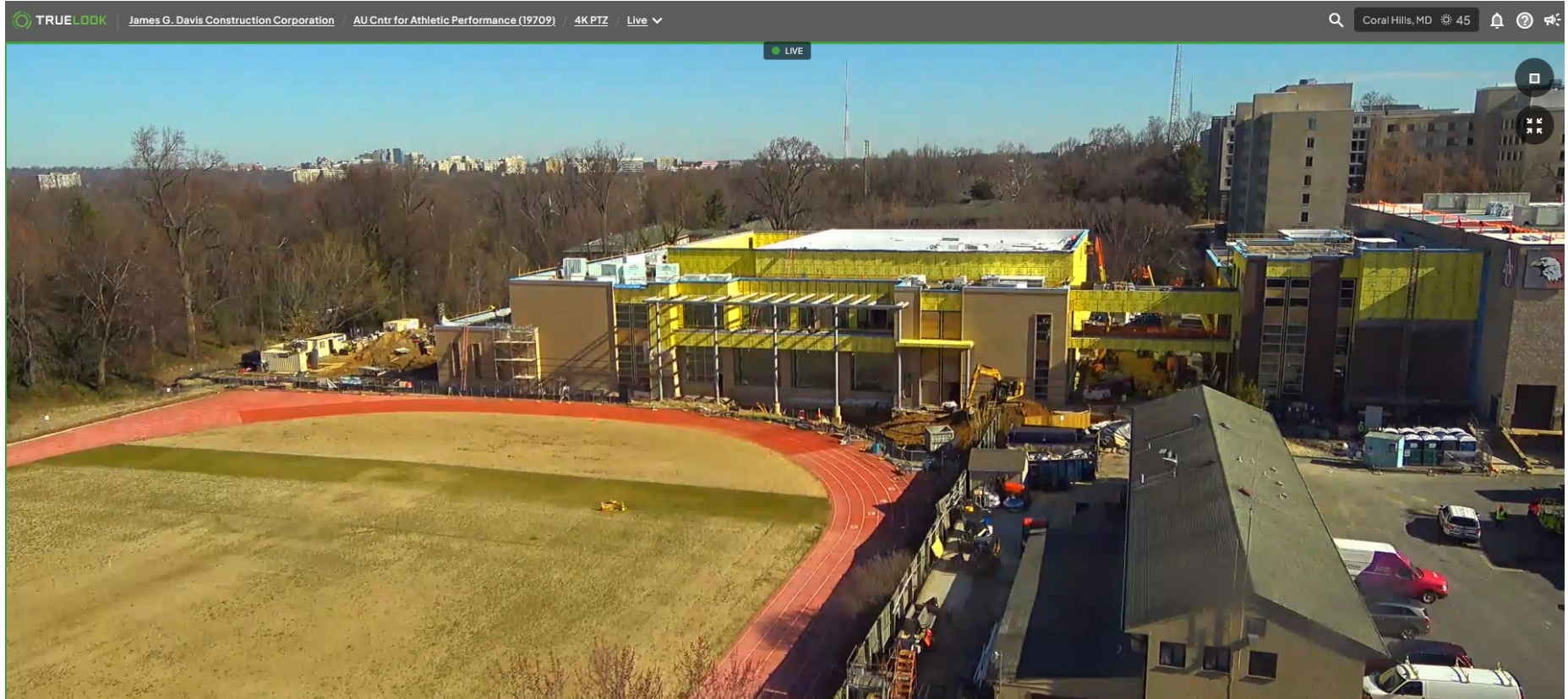

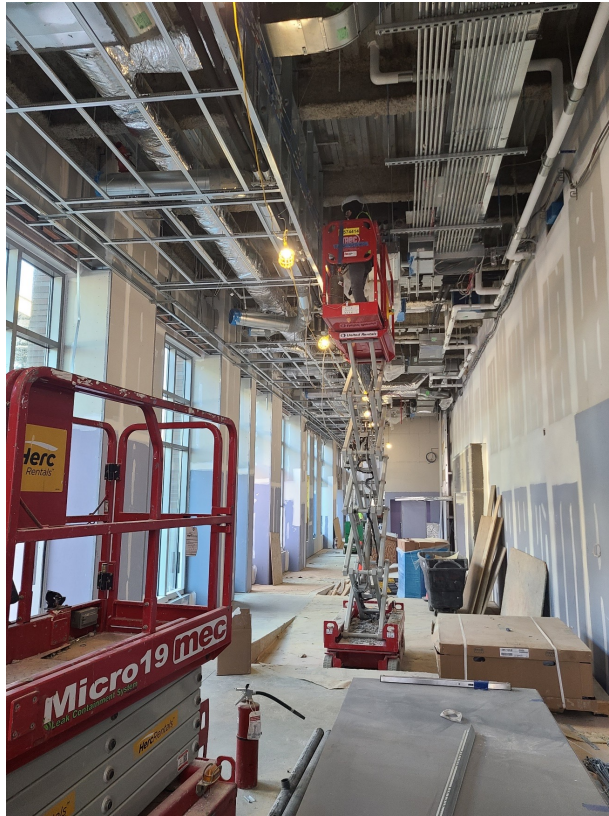

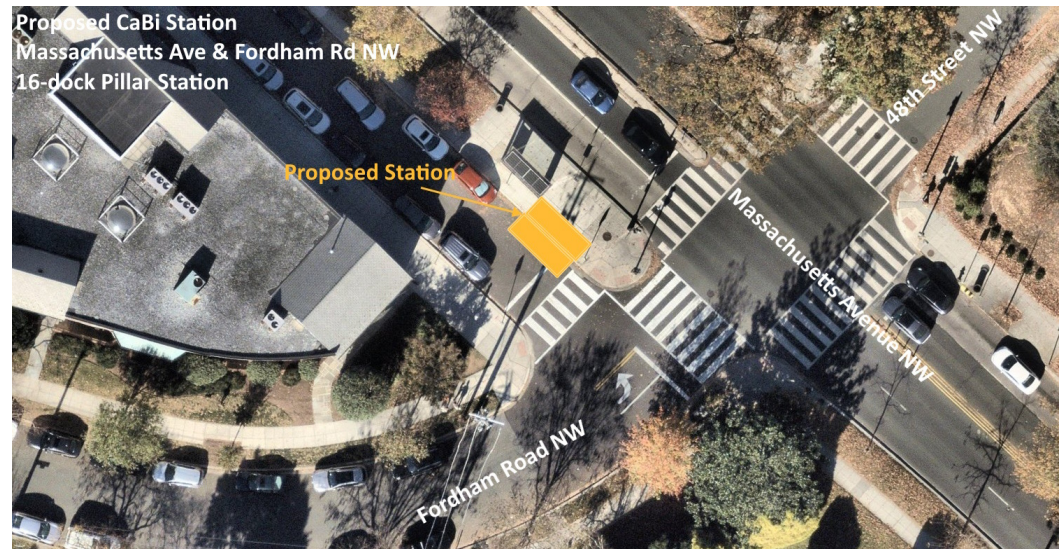

- **New CaBi Station Locations –**
Per DDOT, new stations at Fletcher Gate (Rockwood Parkway) and the Spring Valley Building (see image) are still expected to be completed in the spring. Urban Forestry team able to deploy new technology (Pillar) to allow use of existing hardscape, not take up parking spaces.
