REPORTS:

Construction Update December 6th, 2022







- Construction continues to progress with project completion planned for spring 2023.
- Interior work currently underway and planned to be substantially complete by the end of this year includes finishes (e.g., paint, tile, and flooring) and fixtures (e.g., sinks, appliances, lighting).
- Exterior work currently underway includes painting of siding and gutters.
- Site work has begun and includes renovating the existing retaining wall, refurbishing the existing pool, and landscaping.











- Concrete work has been completed.
- Boulders to be set in place beginning on 12/6.
- Substantial completion planned for end of January 2023.






- ~360 feet long and 15 feet high.

Jacobs Field Sound Barrier




