VANDALISM - HATE

Incident:

On 03/07/2017, individuals reported to the American University Police Department (AUPD) that fliers targeting women were posted in various locations on campus, including Mary Graydon Center, McCabe Hall, McKinley Hall and Kogod School of Business. Safety Tips

- Be aware of those around you and of your surroundings in general.
- Do not leave your doors unlocked, even for brief periods of time.
- Do not let anyone follow you into your residence halls or office area, nor admit anyone as a guest unless they are your guest. Immediately report unattended people with whom you are not familiar to AUPD.
- Report lost keys to AUPD and your building manager immediately.
- Avoid isolated and dark areas.
- Carry your cell phone and keep it accessible.
- If you witness suspicious activity, take note of the person's appearance, clothing and anything unusual.
- Be aware of the emergency telephones located on campus.

General Tips

- The University Police provides escorts for community members to and from University owned property. To arrange an escort, call (202) 885-2527 or use a blue light or red emergency phone.
- Install RAVE Guardian on your cell phone to provide an immediate connection with AUPD and to report tips.
