## **Collection Description**

### **Biographical Note**

Judy Blankenship, (1941-) attended the University of Colorado and the University of Denver. She volunteered in Ecuador with the Peace Corps between 1968 and 1970. After her time in the Peace Corps, she became an award winning and recognized photographer, writer, and editor. She has exhibited photographs that are part of the collections in the National Museums of both Ecuador and Costa Rica.

## **Collection Scope and Content Noted**

This collection contains training materials and publications collected by Judy Blankenship during her service with the Peace Corps in Ecuador between 1968 and 1970. Among the publications in this collection, some of the pamphlets and magazines present include several issues of "Volunteer" Peace Corps Magazine published between 1968 and 1971, a 1967 copy of the Peace Corps Handbook, and 1968-1971 issues of "El Ecuador," a publication created by PC Volunteers in Ecuador. Also present are letters between Peace Corps Volunteers, training reports and memos, meeting minutes and related training materials. The training materials focus on topics such developing leadership skills, community education and development, social structure in Ecuador, and other subjects related to Ecuador and Peace Corps Volunteer training.
