

## ANNETTE LANGDON SCHOLAR-ACTIVIST AWARD **APPLICATION FORM**

The purpose of the Annette Langdon Scholar-Activist (ALSA) Award is to provide financial assistance to deserving undergraduate students who are working to improve the lives of people in under-resource communities. The fund will award \$1,000 to a student.

Applicants must meet the following criteria to be eligible:

- 1) Must be in good academic standing with a minimum GPA of 2.5 and be a full-time student.
- 2) Must be committed to addressing various social causes and should therefore be active in community service and/or social justice organizations.
- 3) Must be a student with financial need. Preference will be given to Pell grant eligible students and/or students with a household income of \$60,000 or less.
- 4) All students are encouraged to apply, but preference will be given to sophomore students majoring in the School of International Service.
