Health and Safety Directive: Self-Screening and Reporting

Effective Date: June 7, 2021

A. Requirements

Students residing in University housing or University-controlled housing, as well as faculty, staff, off-campus/non-residential students, and AU Affiliates who will be physically on campus beginning the Effective Date of this Directive and until further notice must comply with the following self-screening and reporting protocols and report to the University if they test positive for COVID-19, have symptoms, or have been exposed to others who have tested positive for COVID-19.

- 1. Unless exempted under Section A (3) below, complete the Daily Self-Screening via the AU Forward Portal each day that they are physically present on campus. The Daily Self-Screening should be completed and submitted in advance of arrival on campus, or if a University housing student, before departing University housing or University-controlled housing.
- 2. Submit a Self-Report via the AU Forward Portal if they have tested positive for COVID-19, are experiencing symptoms, or are in quarantine or isolation.
- 3. Individuals who are fully vaccinated as defined under the Health and Safety Directive for Mandatory COVID-19 Vaccination do not need to comply with the Daily Self-Screening described in Section A(1) above.

B. Enforcement

Failure to comply with this Health and Safety Directive constitutes misconduct that is actionable under the Student Conduct Code, the Staff Personnel Manual, and the Faculty Manual. Repeated violations by students may result in disciplinary action, up to and including removal from University housing without a refund, as well as suspension or dismissal from the University. Repeated violations by faculty and staff may result in disciplinary action, up to and including suspension or termination. Any individual who fails to follow this Directive may be restricted from the premises.
