Embedded Tutoring Support

What is embedded tutoring support?

- Embedded tutoring support provides a non-remedial approach to learning that supports students toward academic success by integrating “what to learn” with “how to learn.” Embedded tutoring consists of in-class support and out-of-class, one-on-one or group tutoring sessions driven by students’ needs, specifically for the summer semester at American University only. It is implemented in high-risk courses in consultation with faculty and academic departments and is evaluated by Student Academic Services staff. This is a free service offered to all students in eligible courses. All students of various backgrounds are encouraged to schedule tutoring sessions and meet with their Embedded Tutors, as it is a voluntary program.

Who are Embedded Tutors?

- Embedded Tutors are American University students who can articulate course content well and engage their peers academically. Using out-of-class, peer-to-peer collaboration, Tutors will bridge course content that aims to increase student confidence and independence.
