Being a teaching/graduate assistant is an important job. We want all teaching/graduate assistants to feel supported and to be treated equitably. Therefore, if you see or hear or personally experience something that does not seem right or that concerns you, we ask that you reach out to the Office of Equity and Title IX. The Office of Equity and Title IX can provide you with advice or help you to understand your options when it comes to submitting an official report. Please note that you may also file an anonymous complaint to the Office of Equity and Title IX. Also, it is important to note that talking to the Office of Equity and Title IX does not mean that you are filing a complaint or that an investigation is opened. However, in some serious situations, especially in cases of Title IX, AU might be required to report the incident.
