

Online Teaching Assistants: Learning Management Systems and Technology at American University

Learning Outcomes

- 1. Identify the two learning management systems at AU.
- 2. Access resources for future questions about the learning management systems.
- 3. Access resources for future questions about Zoom.

Module Description

A learning management system (LMS) is a software application that organizes instructional materials for effective course delivery. In online courses, the learning management system and course facilitation is especially important so all learners can access all materials for the course. For the Fall 2020 semester at American University faculty have two learning management systems available to them: Canvas and Blackboard. These learning management systems house course content, quizzes, synchronous classes, discussion boards, and all instructional activities and assessments for the course.

Faculty at AU also have access to Zoom. Zoom is a web conferencing platform ideal for setting up recurring synchronous meetings, such as class meetings. Zoom can be used on its own or integrated within Canvas. Please note that Blackboard has its own video conferencing tool: Blackboard Collaborate. Instructors can use the Blackboard LMS and Blackboard Collaborate, or they can use the Blackboard LMS for most course activities, and use Zoom for synchronous meetings. Either is fine and depends on some small differences in tools and preferences of the instructor. Please take a look at the following resources, paying special attention to the learning management system and tools you may be required to facilitate the technology for. For TAs, this might include setting up synchronous meetings, grading, or posting announcements. After reading there is a short, three-question quiz to ensure you know who to contact at American University should you encounter any issues.
