Regulations Governing Transfer Credits

As a matriculated student at AU with a medical permit to study, I may take two courses for up to 8 credits per semester for a maximum of four courses for up to 16 credits from a regionally accredited institution offering a bachelor's degree or higher. Courses must be preapproved.

- 1. Approval is granted for specific courses to undergraduate students in good standing and eligible to return to American University. The course number, title, and description of course content are necessary when the student seeks approval from her/his major department and dean's office.
- 2. Transfer credit is accepted only when the student has secured approval in advance.
- 3. Transfer credit is not given for courses similar in content to those already completed.
- 4. Transfer credit is applicable toward the requirements of the major or minor only with specific departmental approval.
- 5. If a course to be transferred is outside the area of the student's major, the chair of the teaching unit which would offer credit for such a course at American University must also approve the permit by signing in the appropriate space on this form.
- 6. Grades for transfer courses are not recorded on the American University permanent record, and they are not computed in the student's grade point average.
- 7. For students admitted to degree study beginning Fall 1988, the residency requirement is 45 of the last 60 semester hours.
- 8. Transfer credit from a Permit to Study is accepted for courses with earned grades of C or better; application of these credits toward fulfilling major, minor, or University Requirements follows the grade requirement published in the AU Catalog.
- 9. Once final grades have been posted at the other U.S. institution, students should request that an official transcript be forwarded to the Office of the Registrar, Student Record Services in a sealed envelope. Documentation provided must clearly identify course level as undergraduate work.
