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## **About the SIS Employer Matching Program**

Newly admitted SIS students can apply to have their employer educational benefits matched by SIS for **up** to \$5,000 each year for a maximum of two consecutive academic years. The total SIS contribution will not exceed the maximum annual contribution from your employer and will be no greater than \$5,000 each academic year. Availability and amount of support is budget-contingent for each admission cycle. Priority consideration is given to students who have not been awarded other SIS merit funding. Please also note that students are responsible for ensuring that the employer benefit funding is remitted to American University.
