You will be able to explore the many facets of communication from creating a film to becoming a better public speaker; from wherever you are in the world. There are a few things that will need to happen to make everything run smoothly.

- Information about registration

Registration

Now that you have registered and paid for the DWC Online Course(s), here is what we are doing before you will be able to begin your class:

- 1. Your AU ID is created
- 2. You are officially registered by Students Accounts
- 3. Your account is created, this allows you to access your AU email and Blackboard.
- 4. Your AU ID, username and password are sent to you

Your AU ID

We have taken the information provided to us by you in your registration to be able to create your AU ID number. The AU ID is a 7-digit number that is your unique identification within the AU computer system. You will need this to request a transcript (if taking a course for college credit), access the library, and receive help from the Help Desk. DWC staff will provide you with your AU ID before the start of the program. Please write it down so you don't forget it. If you do misplace or forget it, contact us at audiscover@american.edu and we can send it to you.

Your Student Account

After Student Accounts has registered you, you will receive an email with your AU ID, username and password. You will use this username and password to log into your American University email as well as Blackboard.

You will receive detailed instructions on how to change your password and access Blackboard once your account has been created.

Accessing Blackboard

American University students and professors take advantage of the Blackboard e-Education platform, a unique electronic classroom designed to transform the internet into a powerful learning environment. All class documents and readings are posted on the Blackboard site, and you will turn in your final assignments to the Blackboard site. To access your class Blackboard site, go to <u>blackboard.american.edu</u> and log in. Your course should automatically appear on your screen. Click on your class to access all the material your professor has put online for you.

1. To access your course on American University's electronic Blackboard platform go to: <u>blackboard.american.edu</u>

2. When logging on to Blackboard, please be sure to use this format: <u>username@american.edu</u>. (Discover the World of Communication will send this information before the course begins. If you didn't receive it, please check your spam folder and if it is not there, email us at audiscover@american.edu)

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS: FAQ's (Keep a copy of these, as you may need them in the future)

What's my AU ID?

Your AU ID number is a 7-digit number that is your unique identification within the AU computer system. You will need this to request a transcript, access the library, and receive help from the Help Desk. DWC staff will provide you with your AU ID before the start of the program. Please write it down so you don't forget it. If you misplace or forget it, contact us at audiscover@american.edu and we can send it to you.

What is my Username and Password?

Your username is used to access all American University computer systems. DWC staff sent your username and password. Please write them down so you don't forget them.

Do I have AU Email?

As an AU student, you will be assigned an AU email address. To check your AU email, log in to <u>http://mail.student.american.edu</u> using your username and password. To ensure that you don't miss any important emails from us and to fully participate in the Blackboard site, you should forward your AU email to an email account you regularly check.

Forwarding your AU Email?

- 3. The University may take photographs and make other recordings of me during the Program. I consent to the use of my name and these photographs and recordings, without compensation, in any promotional materials and publications related to the educational activities of American University.
- 4. I understand that if I do not comply with these rules or otherwise conduct myself in a responsible manner, American University ("University") may remove me from the Program. And I will be sent home at my owncost.

Fitness to Participate and Emergency Medical Treatment: 1) I agree to conduct myself in a safe and prudent manner while participating in any activity or travel conducted by or under the auspices of American University; 2) I represent to American University that there are no health-related reasons or other problems of which I am aware that preclude or restrict me from participating in this Program, and 3) I hereby authorize the University to secure necessary emergency medical treatment in the event of injury or illness while participating in the Program.
