Voice of America is looking for highly skilled Dean's Interns to work in the award winning Documentary and Special Projects unit at Voice of America, part of the Central News Division.

Pre-requisites and Role:

- A minimum OVERALL GPA of 3.5 and no academic violations
- Technical experience specifically in Premiere or Adobe to assist in the pre-production phase
- Strong research and investigative skills to look for interesting cutting edge stories and transcribe interviews
- Participate in identifying subject matter experts for interviews in the field and studio
- Must be able to work in challenging and exciting environment
- Must be a junior, senior or graduate student with a major or minor in SOC

VOA documentaries have a strong focus on issues oriented programming. Previous documentaries include:

- "AIDS: Living in the Shadows" hosted by Sir Elton John that looked at the stigma of AIDS
- "A Single Step" hosted by Academy Award winning actress Sally Field, looked at the journey of women leaders around the world inspired by the 4th World Conference in Beijing
- "JFK: A Legacy Remembered" looked at the legacy of President John F Kennedy 50 years after his assassination in Dallas
- "A Fateful Harvest" looked at the opium trade in Afghanistan and how this multi-billion dollar drug business ultimately challenges the stability of Afghanistan.
