RFA to be released late spring / early summer 2023.



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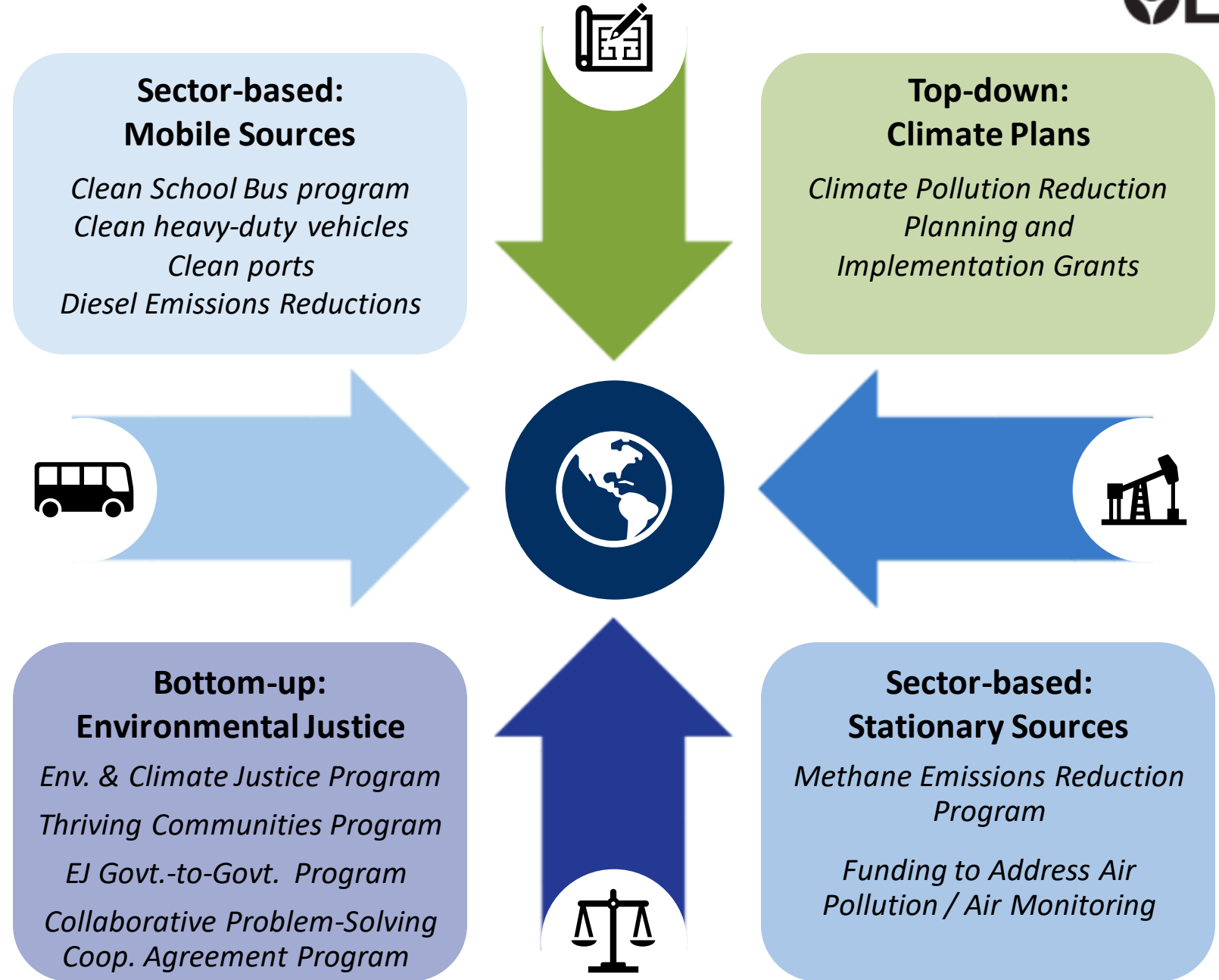


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Climate Pollution Reduction Grants (CPRG)

Tackling Climate and Air Pollution from Multiple Angles



Climate Pollution Reduction Grant (CPRG) Program

1. Planning grants to develop strong climate pollution reduction strategies (\$250 million)

- Administered through non-competitive cooperative agreements

2. Competitive implementation grants to help put plans into action (\$4.6 billion)

CPRG: Planning Grant Allocations

States: \$156 million
*Up to \$3M per state +
DC + Puerto Rico*

Locals: \$67 million
*Up to \$1M each for the
67 most populous
metropolitan areas*

Territories: \$2 million
*Up to \$500K each for US
Virgin Islands, Guam,
American Samoa,
Northern Mariana Islands*

Tribes: \$25 million
*Up to \$500K per tribe or
\$1M for groups of 2 or
more*
