Mr. James F. Geurts, a member of the Senior Executive Service, is the Deputy Director, Special Operations Research, Development, and Acquisition Center (SORDAC), for United States Special Operations Command (USSOCOM), MacDill Air Force Base, Florida. He is responsible for all Special Operations Forces (SOF) research, development, acquisition, procurement, and logistics, assisting the USSOCOM Acquisition Executive in overseeing more than \$5 billion in SOF-peculiar acquisition and support activities annually.
