Jeffery R. Shelton, a member of the Senior Executive Service, is Deputy Director of Resource Integration, Deputy Chief of Staff for Logistics, Installations and Mission Support, Headquarters U.S. Air Force, Washington, D.C. He is responsible for the planning, programming and budgeting of weapons systems sustainment. equipment, and logistics and installations resource requirements. As part of the Air Force corporate structure, he monitors performance of operations and maintenance, working capital funds and investment programs; participates in program and financial review groups; and advocates for financial adjustments to optimize force readiness. He oversees preparation and defense of these Air Force programs to the Office of the Secretary of Defense, Office of Management and Budget, and Congress. In addition, he is a member of the Air Force Board for Correction of Military Records.

Mr. Shelton, a native of South Carolina, entered federal service in 1981 and spent his first four years at Warner Robins Air Logistics Center, Robins Air Force Base, Ga. He was then assigned



to the Joint Depot Maintenance Analysis Group, Gentile Air Force Station, Ohio, where he served in a variety of assignments including systems program manager and policy officer. Mr. Shelton completed a two-year logistics career broadening position and then moved to Wright-Patterson AFB, Ohio, where he was the Command Public and Private Competition Program Manager.

In 1999, he returned to Washington, D.C., where he has served in management and leadership positions with the Secretary of the Air Force for Acquisition, Secretary of the Air Force for Financial Management and Budget, and the Secretary of the Air Force for Warfighting, Integration and Chief Information Office. Mr. Shelton was appointed to the Senior Executive Service in May 2008. Prior to his current assignment, he was the Associate Deputy Assistant Secretary for Acquisition Integration, Office of the Assistant Secretary of the Air Force for Acquisition, Washington, D.C.
