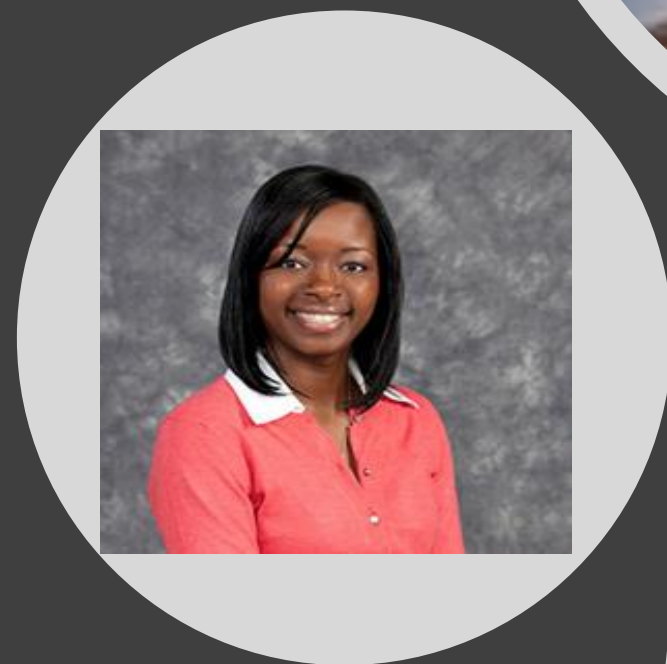

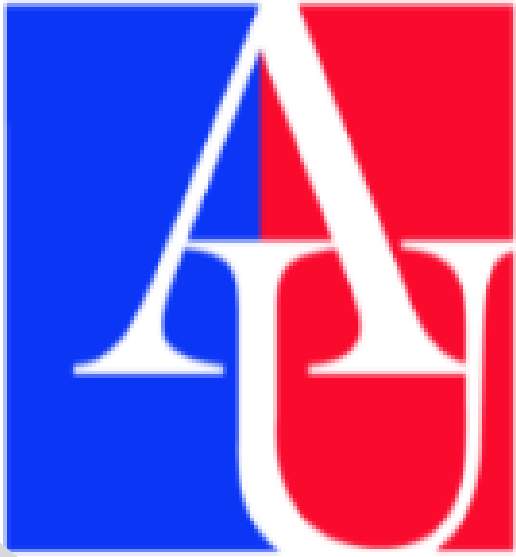
Professor Haney teaches SPA 361 and is the Associate Director for Leadership Development for the University Center & Student Activities.
