The purpose of the award is to support an undergraduate student enrolled in a degree program in the School of Public Affairs who through their research or activism have advanced the cause of social justice.

The inaugural Spring 2022 Sherman Prize will be awarded to one SPA undergraduate student in the amount of \$500. Please note that the award is taxable and nonrenewable.

Eligible students will be considered by the award committee if they are:

- enrolled in an SPA major and
- in good standing with American University.
