

Seeking 3 camera operators to film a high quality, thought-provoking documentary film!

About the film:

- Serves as a capstone project for Emily Arndt, AU M.A. Political Communication student
- Working title: *The Space Between*; length: 40 minutes
- Features in-person, in-depth interviews with four diverse Americans to show how uniquely personal politics is, and to give four people the opportunity to share how their life experiences have shaped their politics and perspectives. Audiences' stereotypes of the subjects will be challenged. The subjects vary in race, age, political party, and life experiences.

Needed: 3 camera operators

- 1 camera operator will serve as director of photography (DoP)
- Film experience appreciated but not required
- Interest in politics appreciated but not required
- No equipment needed

Filming schedule and location:

- From mid-late March
- Can be flexible based on student schedules (e.g. b-roll footage can be filmed on own time)
