



Prior to joining H&R Block, **Bailey Childers** served as Executive Director of the National Public Pension Coalition (NPPC), where she led national and state efforts to advance retirement security for working Americans. Before joining NPPC, Childers managed state legislative efforts to support progressive tax and budget policies at the Center on Budget and Policy Priorities. Additionally, Childers managed national and state electoral and legislative campaigns for AFSCME for four years.

A seasoned political operative, Childers spent much of her career running high-capacity field and GOTV efforts for Hillary Clinton in 2008 and 2016, the DNC in 2006, and John Kerry in 2004.
