# ANNOUNCEMENTS

**#1 REMINDER!** Remember to submit your <u>Request for Certification</u> to the American University Veteran Services Office. Make sure to check your eligibility for VA education benefits prior to registering for classes. For more information about your benefit payment amount and T&F rates, visit the <u>Veterans Services AU</u> <u>Knowledge Base</u>. For updated GI Bill and Yellow Ribbon Match rates for the 2021-22 Academic Year, visit our info-article about the <u>Yellow Ribbon Program</u>. To check if you are eligible to receive Yellow Ribbon, complete this <u>preapplication questionnaire</u>.

**#2 Tuition & Fees Update:** <u>The tuition and fees for the 2021-2022 Academic</u> <u>Year</u> will return to the standard rate.

**#3 Update to the "<u>Rounding-out</u>" rule!!!** Beginning on Aug. 1, 2021, students can "round out" in their last term only if they are taking classes that are approved for their program of education.

**#4** <u>Waive your health insurance fee,</u> if you are already covered under a **Health Insurance plan** and are **attending AU full-time**. The deadline to submit a Fall waiver request is **September 17, 2021**

#### LAST, BUT NOT LEAST!

**STEP 1:** Complete a <u>VA</u> <u>Benefits application</u> to use your VA Education Benefits.

**STEP 2:** Send a copy of your Certificate of Eligibility or a snapshot of your VA Education benefits summary from va.gov to veterans@american.edu

**STEP 3:** Meet with your academic advisor to create an academic plan

**STEP 4:** Register for classes! This step must be completed before submitting your Request for Certification

**STEP 5:** Complete a <u>Request</u> for <u>Certification form</u>. This serves as your request to use VA Education Benefits for the upcoming semester.

**STEP 6:** If applicable, complete a <u>Yellow Ribbon Application</u>

**STEP 7:** Review your bill at <u>Eagle Service</u> and note what portion of your bill will not be covered by VA Education Benefits.

**STEP 8:** <u>Waive your health</u> <u>insurance</u> if you are already covered under a Health Insurance plan (VA or Disability health coverage) and are attending AU full-time.

**STEP 9:** Set up your <u>direct</u> <u>deposit account</u> so you can receive all portions of your VA Education benefits

What Programs Are Not Covered by My VA Education Benefits?

#### **DID YOU KNOW?**

The Post-9/11 GI Bill (Chapter 33) helps you pay for school or job training. If you've served on active duty after September 10, 2001, you may qualify for the Post-9/11 GI Bill (Chapter 33). While the GI Bill covers up to the full cost of tuition for <u>undergraduate and graduate</u> <u>degrees</u>, <u>correspondence training</u>, and <u>distance learning</u> at Institutes of Higher Learning (IHL), there are various specific IHL programs that are not approved for VA Education Benefits. Before using your VA Education benefits at American University, check the list below to verify that your program of study does not fall under the category of "currently in review" or "not covered". Keep in mind that this is not a permanent list of unapproved/pending approval programs. Every year, the VA reevaluates which programs are or are not



covered under VA benefits. Still have questions? Check out the knowledge article titled "<u>Is my Graduate Certificate</u> <u>Approved for VA Benefits?</u>" for more information about programs that are approved for VA Benefits. You can also reference the <u>WEAMS LIST</u> to review all of the programs that are currently approved by our State Approving Agency and the VA. NOTICE: All courses not taken at American University's main campus located in Washington, D.C. excluding online courses, are currently under review for VA approval. If you are planning to enroll in a program that is taught at an American University subsidiary site (including Study Abroad) please confirm with the Veteran Services office before enrolling in that program.
