

AUWCL COST OF ATTENDANCE SUMMER 2025

The Cost of Attendance (COA) is the maximum amount of financial aid permitted. Costs are associated with and limited to the period of enrollment.

Living expense refunds, if applicable, are available after all spring grades are posted and satisfactory academic progress is confirmed. Financial aid cannot disburse early to cover expenses.

Enrollment in a minimum of three credit hours is required to receive federal financial aid.

For the summer term, federal student loan recipients that request the maximum amount will receive an offset of \$285 in the cost of attendance based on average loan fees incurred at disbursement.

For students attending summer classes (minimum of 3 credits) and approved for Federal Work-Study (FWS), the FWS award is included in the summer COA and reduces federal student loan eligibility by the amount of the FWS award. A separate FWS application is required.

HOW TO APPLY FOR SUMMER FINANCIAL AID

1. Complete a 2025-2026 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). For summer 2025, students are generally eligible for the Unsubsidized loan up to \$10,250.
2. Finalize your summer registration in 3 or more credits.
3. Students who wish to borrow additional funds beyond the Unsubsidized loan should complete a 2025-2026 Direct PLUS Loan application for the May 2025 to August 2025 loan period, indicating maximum, at <https://studentaid.gov>. The Direct PLUS Loan is available up to the COA (including living expenses) minus all other aid awarded.
Note: COA will be determined by your registration as reflected on your bill at time of processing.
4. Submit all applications by priority deadline of **May 5, 2025**, for timely processing.
